Foot and Mouth Disease

Low risk - no change

In November, a small number of outbreaks of FMD serotype O were reported in Myanmar (13), FMD serotype SAT1 in Zimbabwe (22), FMD serotype SAT2 in Zimbabwe (1) and South Africa (11), FMD serotype SAT3 in Namibia (3).

Highly Pathogenic Avian Influenza

Low risk for wild bird incursion – no change

In November, a small number of outbreaks were reported in domestic poultry: HPAI H5N2 in Taiwan (3), and HPAI H5N5 in Taiwan (2).

African Swine Fever

Medium risk – no change

In November, in **Europe**, reported outbreaks of ASF have continued in backyard pig and commercial pig premises in Romania (99) and Ukraine (2). Reports in wild boar continue in Belgium (1), Bulgaria (33), Estonia (4), Hungary (99), Italy (15), Latvia (52), Lithuania (23), Poland (167), Romania (55), Slovakia (3) and Ukraine (1). In **Asia**, China (3), Philippines (24) and Vietnam (9) have reported new outbreaks of ASF in domestic pigs. **Elsewhere**, there were outbreaks of ASF in domestic pigs in South Africa (2), Zimbabwe (6) as well as Russia (3), and Moldova (2). ASF in wild boar has also been reported in Russia (10), Moldova (1) and South Korea (15).

Classical Swine Fever

Very low risk – no change

In November, Japan has reported an outbreak of CSF in domestic pigs (6) and a large number of cases in wild boar (120). Elsewhere, there was a report of CSF in Brazil (1).





Bluetongue


Low risk – no change

In November, there were reports of BTV-8 in Switzerland (23), in Belgium (2), in Germany (2), BTV-4 in Italy (1), BTV-1 in Italy (2), and BTV-16 in Cyprus (2).


Newcastle disease


Low risk - no change

In November, there were outbreaks of ND in Russia (2), Romania (1) and USA (4).
















Classical swine fever disease in Japan from August 2019




Foot and Mouth Disease: April - November 2019
