



- Foot and Mouth Disease [Low risk no change] In October, a small number of outbreaks of FMD serotype O were reported in Guinea-Bissau (6).
- Highly Pathogenic Avian Influenza [Low risk for wild bird incursion no change] In October, outbreaks were reported in domestic poultry: HPAI H5N2 in Taiwan (2), HPAI H5N5 in Taiwan (1), HPAI H5N6 in Vietnam (1), HPAI H7N3 in Mexico (6), and HPAI H5N8 in South Africa (1).
- African Swine Fever [Medium risk no change] In October, in Europe, reported outbreaks of ASF have continued in backyard pig and commercial pig premises in Bulgaria (3), Lithuania (2), Poland (2), Romania (95), and Ukraine (2). Reports in wild boar continue in Bulgaria (13), Estonia (6), Hungary (156), Latvia (39), Lithuania (32), Poland (161), Romania (47), and Slovakia (4). In Asia, China (2), Philippines (9), South Korea (6) and Laos (47) have reported new outbreaks of ASF in domestic pigs. Elsewhere, there were outbreaks of ASF in domestic pigs in Cote d'Ivoire (3), Kenya (1), as well as Russia (21), and Moldova (1). ASF in wild boar has also been reported in Russia (12), Moldova (1) and South Korea (15).
- Classical Swine Fever [Very low risk no change] In October, Japan has reported an outbreak of CSF in domestic pigs (1) and a large number of cases in wild boar (109). Elsewhere, there were reports of CSF in Brazil (3).
- **Bluetongue** [Low risk no change] In October, there were a small number of reports of BTV-8 in Switzerland (3), BTV-4 in Italy (6), and BTV-16 in Greece (1).
- Newcastle disease [Low risk no change] In October, there were outbreaks of ND in Russia (5), and no new outbreaks in the USA, or elsewhere.
















Classical swine fever disease in Japan from August 2019








Foot and mouth disease from April-October 2019
