#### **Foot and Mouth Disease**

# Low risk – no change

In February, there was a single outbreak of FMD serotype SAT2 in South Africa.

# **Highly Pathogenic Avian Influenza**

#### Low risk for wild bird incursion – no change

In February, outbreaks of HPAI were reported in domestic poultry: HPAI H5N1 in China (1), HPAI H5N6 in China (1), HPAI H5N2 in Taiwan (14), HPAI H5N5 in Taiwan (1), HPAI H5N1 in India (1), HPAI H5N1 in Vietnam (5), HPAI H5N6 in Vietnam (29) and HPAI H5N8 in Saudi Arabia (1). HPAI H5N8 was identified in a wild bird (eagle) in Israel (1). In **Europe**, outbreaks of HPAI H5N8 in domestic poultry were reported in the Bulgaria (3), Czech Republic (1), Germany (1), Poland (9).

#### **African Swine Fever**

#### Medium risk – no change

In February, in **Europe**, reported outbreaks of ASF have continued in backyard pig and commercial pig premises in Bulgaria (5), Greece (1 – first reported outbreak of ASF), Romania (51) and Ukraine (1). Reports in wild boar continue in Belgium (1), Bulgaria (59), Estonia (5), Hungary (292), Italy (4), Latvia (19), Lithuania (11), Poland (374), Romania (99), Serbia (8), Slovakia (7), and Ukraine (1). In **Asia**, the Philippines (39) have reported new outbreaks of ASF in domestic pigs. **Elsewhere**, there were outbreaks of ASF in domestic pigs in Russia (2), Moldova (1), Myanmar (1) and Sierra Leone (11). ASF in wild boar has also been reported in Russia (12), Moldova (5), and South Korea (121).





### **Classical Swine Fever**

### Very low risk – no change

In February, Japan has reported one outbreak of CSF in domestic pigs. As with last month, this was on the island of Okinawa. There was a large number of cases reported in wild boar (161). In Russia there were three cases of CSF in wild boar. These were in the east, near to the Sea of Japan (East Sea).

# Low risk - no change

In February, there were reports of BTV-8 in Belgium (1 - cattle), BTV-4 in Italy (1 - buffalo), and BTV-1 in Italy (1 - cattle).


### **Newcastle disease**


### Low risk - no change

In February, there were outbreaks of ND in Russia (1) and USA (3) in backyard poultry.
















Bluetongue disease in Europe: September 2019 - February 2020
