Foot and Mouth Disease

Low risk - no change

In May, there were two outbreaks of FMD in South Africa (serotype SAT2), and one outbreak in Turkey (serotype O).

Highly Pathogenic Avian Influenza

Low risk for wild bird incursion – no change

In May, outbreaks of HPAI were reported in domestic poultry: HPAI H5N5 in Taiwan (3), HPAI H5N8 in Iraq (1), and in Vietnam HPAI H5N1 (3) and HPAI H5N6 (2). In **Europe**, outbreaks of HPAI H5N8 in domestic poultry were reported in Hungary (22). African Swine Fever

Medium risk – no change

In May, in **Europe**, reported outbreaks of ASF have continued in backyard pig and commercial pig premises in Romania (35), Russia (2) and Ukraine (2). Reports in wild boar continue in Bulgaria (18), Estonia (2), Hungary (396), Latvia (12), Lithuania (15), Moldova (4), Poland (264), Romania (49), Russia (1) and Slovakia (27). In **Asia**, India (11) and the Philippines (54) have reported new outbreaks of ASF in domestic pigs. ASF in wild boar has also been reported in and South Korea (45). In **Africa**, there were outbreaks reported in domestic pigs in Namibia (20) and South Africa (3).

Classical Swine Fever

Very low risk - no change

In May, Japan reported large numbers of cases in wild boar (105).

Bluetongue

Low risk - no change

In May, there was one outbreak of BTV in Italy (BTV-4 in cattle). Elsewhere, there were no other reports.

Newcastle disease

Low risk - no change

In May, there was one outbreak of ND reported in North Macedonia.


African Horse Sickness

Very low risk – no change

In May, Thailand reported five new outbreaks. These have been in the districts of Ban Na, Bang Pahan, Muak Lek, Phatthana Nikhom and Sanam Chai Khet. Elsewhere, one outbreak was reported in Eswatini (Swaziland). 

















Bluetongue disease in Europe: December 2019 - May 2020











Foot and Mouth Disease, November 2019 - April 2020
