


Worcestershire Sauce is made from anchovies

Pearlescence - the silver shiny substance found in fish scales - is often used in cosmetics to give them that glow and shimmer




Fish is a good source of **IRON**

In Japan they eat fresh raw fish (usually squid) served in a sauce made of fermented fish/squid guts



To test how fresh a fish is, put it in cold water and if it floats (or swims away) it's fresh!
