The Cabinet Secretary believes that the information is interesting but is not convinced that further analysis would be productive in giving useful policy data. Ms Hyslop is of the view that it is not the differences, or what drives these differences, that would be useful but an exploration of the actual experiences of those who responded and Ms Hyslop is not convinced the MCS cohort study lets you go back to individuals in this way.

As such, Ms Hyslop is content to note the findings and arrangements for the MCS3 publication but is not convinced by this submission to agree to more detailed analysis of the data.
