

Criminal Proceedings in Scotland, 2013-14: Note of Erratum

This document provides details of a correction made to Criminal Proceedings statistics on people proceeded against under the Offensive Behaviour at Football and Threatening Communications (Scotland) Act 2012. These figures were originally published in the publication [Criminal Proceedings, 2013-14](#) at Annex E.

The split between those found guilty and those found not guilty was incorrect for those proceeded against under “offensive behaviour at football” offences as follows:

- In 2012-13 one person was incorrectly presented as “not guilty”.
- In 2013-14 six persons were incorrectly presented as “not guilty”.

The corrected table is presented below.
