What is statistics.gov.scot?

- An open data portal, hosting (mostly) official statistics
- Contains 252 linked data datasets on a range of topics
- Data comes from statistics producers such as NHS ISD,
 Scottish Government, and National Records of Scotland



Wait a minute, what is open data?

- Accessible
- Free of restriction on use or redistribution in its licensing conditions.
- In a digital, machine readable format for use with other data
- But information is only useful if people can find it, understand it, and easily combine it with other sources of information.
