**Additional Case Information:**

On the 31/8/2020 a report was received of a suspected farmed fish caught on the river Naver displaying mild haemorrhaging around the pectoral fins. The fish had been removed from the river and frozen, it was decided that no samples would be taken for diagnostic purposes due to having being frozen. The FHI contacted all fish farm sites within the vicinity of the river to determine if any escapes had occurred. No fish of similar size to the suspected escapee were held in nearby fish farms. It was requested that scale samples were sent to the local DSFB (as per Fisheries Management Scotland guidance) to determine if indeed the salmon was of farmed origin. It was requested that the outcome of the scale reading was reported to the Inspectorate.
