## Guide to information available through the Scottish Agricultural Wages Board Publication Scheme

#### Introduction

This is the guide to information published by the Scottish Agricultural Wages
Board (SAWB) which is required by the Freedom of Information (Scotland) Act
2002 to maintain a publication scheme. The SAWB is a non-departmental
public body of the Scottish Government and we follow a number of Scottish
Government policies in relation to freedom of information law.

The SAWB has adopted the Scottish Information Commissioner's Model Publication Scheme 2015

### **Availability and formats**

We offer alternative arrangements for people who do not want to, or cannot, access the information online or by inspection at our premises. For example, we can usually arrange to send information to you in paper copy (although there may be a charge for this - see charges below).

### **Exempt information**

We will publish the information we hold that falls within the classes of information below. If a document contains information that is exempt under Scotland's freedom of information laws (for example sensitive personal information or a trade secret), we will remove or 'black out' the information before publication and explain why. #### Copyright

Where the SAWB holds the copyright in its published information, the information may be copied or reproduced without formal permission, provided that:

it is copied or reproduced accurately;

it is not used in a misleading context; and

the source of the material is identified.

Where the SAWB does not hold the copyright in information we publish, we will make this clear.

#### **Charges**

Information about the SAWB is available on the Scottish Government's website. There is no charge to users for information which can be downloaded from the Scottish Government's web site. For those without access to the web site a single printout as on the web site or, where available, a hard copy of the document can be requested from us. This will be provided free of charge. However, requests for multiple printouts of material on the web site or for multiple hard copies may attract a charge.
