LORD BONOMY'S REVIEW

Please may I submit three points, in connection with fox control, to be considered in Lord Bonomy's Review.

1. According to Scottish Government records, for a number of years now, there have been no prosecutions brought against Scottish Huts for cruelty to foxes.
2. The use of a number of hounds, rather than two, to flush foxes

to guns, from densely wooded and upland areas, typical to Scotland, is a recognised derogation of the Law.

3. Since 2002 Scottish Hunts have continued to be supported by farmers and rural communities. In rural areas hunts provide additional means of employment where there are very few employment opportunities.
