

LCITP – Innovative Local Energy Systems

As part of the Scottish Government’s Low Carbon Infrastructure Transition Programme, an invitation to apply for funds to support Innovative Local Energy Systems has been designed to support and accelerate the development and delivery of innovative, local low carbon energy opportunities across Scotland. In particular, it aims to support solutions in rural and remote parts of Scotland, smaller towns and settlements, and areas that are off gas grid.

This invite is for Stage 1 support (up to £100,000) and will focus on developing full, investment-ready business proposals. Projects must provide 50% match funding, business proposals funded by this support must be completed by March 2018.

In addition, two projects have been approved for immediate capital support to deliver demonstrator projects by December 2018.
