



## £1.1 billion

In 2021 to 2022, Scottish public sector bodies spent just over £1.1 billion on goods and services through our national contracts and frameworks. An increase of approx 10% on 2020 to 2021.



## £161 million

Amount saved for the public sector by our contracts.



### Good for businesses and their employees



Of the £420 million that Scottish Government spent through its contracts, just over **£174 million** went directly to SMEs. Many more SMEs also won work in our supply chains as subcontractors. These subcontractors shared at least **£60 million** of work, with Scottish SMEs receiving at least **£51 million** of that.

### Good for society



As well as continuing to support thousands of existing jobs, our contracts enabled the creation of **428** brand-new jobs, **48** apprenticeships, **33** work placements and **45** qualifications.

### Good for places and communities



We currently have 40 live contracts valued at nearly **£1.7 billion** within which community benefits are embedded.

### Open and Connected



Across Scotland, **over 490 organisations** used Public Contracts Scotland (PCS) to advertise **15,635 contract opportunities** resulting in **18,880 suppliers** winning contracts.
