Principal Policy 11 is not clear if the range of matters highlighted in subsections (c) and (d) will be the only matters addressed in supplementary guidance or if further matters will be introduced. The final paragraph of Principal Policy 11 is sufficiently open to allow other matters to be introduced but this would not be a sufficient connection to allow those other matters to be introduced only at the supplementary guidance stage.</p> | |
