**TOWN AND COUNTRY PLANNING (SCOTLAND) ACT 1997
NOTICE OF INTENTION TO ADOPT: SUPPLEMENTARY GUIDANCE**

I refer to your correspondence of 15 September 2016, notifying Scottish Ministers of your intention to adopt the documents titled: Delivering Zero Waste; Loch Leven Special Protection Area and Ramsar Site; Lunan Valley Area Dunkeld-Blaigowrie Loch Special Area of Conservation; and River Tay Special Area of Conservation, in association with the Perth and Kinross Local Development Plan.

Scottish Ministers do not propose to issue a direction in relation to these documents.

Prior to adopting the documents as supplementary guidance, your Authority should satisfy itself that it has met the requirements set out in the Town and Country Planning (Development Planning) (Scotland) Regulations 2008.

In particular, we would bring to your attention the need to comply with section 27(2) of the above regulations, which state that supplementary guidance adopted and issued under section 22(1) of the 1997 Act (in connection with a particular local development plan), may only deal with the provision of further information or detail in respect of the policies or proposals set out in the plan and then only provided that those are matters which are expressly identified in a statement contained in the plan as matters which are to be dealt with in supplementary guidance.

Please note, as of 5 September 2016, we changed our approach to our involvement in Development Plan preparation. Details for this are set out in the Development Plan Gateway [Service Standard](#).
