Environmental Assessment (Scotland) Act 2005: Section 8(1) National Transport Strategy (NTS2) Delivery Plan

Screening Determination

I refer to the Screening report prepared for the above, which was submitted to the SEA Gateway on 04/11/2020. Responses from the Consultation Authorities were received on 02/12/2020, whose overall opinion was that there was no likelihood of significant environmental effects.

I write to confirm that the Scottish Government has determined, using the criteria set out in Schedule 2 of the Environmental Assessment (Scotland) Act 2005, that the NTS2 Delivery Plan is unlikely to have significant environmental effects. As the Consultation Authorities agree with this view, the Scottish Government has concluded that a Strategic Environmental Assessment is not required.
