# Minimum Unit Pricing from 1 May 2018. 

## Retailers cannot legally sell alcohol below the minimum unit price.



For example, this will mean the proposed minimum price for the following:

| Product | Strength (ABV) | Volume | Minimum Price |
| :---: | :---: | :---: | :---: |
| Whisky | $40 \%$ | 700 ml | $£ 14.00$ |
| Vodka/Gin | $37.5 \%$ | 700 ml | $£ 13.13$ |
| Wine | $13 \%$ | 750 ml | $£ 4.88$ |
| Beer | $5 \%$ | $4 \times 440 \mathrm{ml}$ cans | $£ 4.40$ |
| Cider | $5 \%$ | 2000 ml | $£ 5.00$ |

The Scottish Government is introducing this to reduce alcohol-related harm.
