- Sample Bills and Draft Templates
 - Consult Glasgow City Council to find out whether barcode at bottom of letter is required
 - Kevin to find out if current system is able to incorporate transfers into the standard template
 - Kevin to check correct deadline for appeals to resolve conflicting information on Dumfries and Galloway back page
- Seeking feedback
 - Templates to be sent out electronically for stakeholder feedback in early September; response deadline mid-October
 - Templates to go out to councils in late October/early November; response deadline end January
- IT Options
 - Investigate possibility of introducing a standard contract for councils;

Decisions

Sample Bills and Draft Templates

- Formatting and content of Front page agreed
 - Version 4 preferred, although redundant second line from personalised message to be removed
 - Personalised message to precede everything else in body of letter
 - Large Bill breakdown box agreed. Content should be kept standard where possible with limited scope for variation
 - Upper box agreed and could be used to include any supplements (e.g. out of town supplement)
 - A box for payments/adjustments to be included

Back page

- Formatting of East Lothian back page preferred, but some information from the Dumfries and Galloway back page on how the rates are calculated should be included
- Both back pages will be sent out for user research to find out which is preferred

IT Options

- Standard national contract
 - Group agreed it would be desirable to develop a standard national contract template, developed centrally but deployed locally rather than developing an national IT system.
 - May need to wait for current contracts to run their course
 - o Preferable for E-billing to be included in any new contract
 - Consideration needs to be given to the interactions between NDR and Council Tax IT systems
