

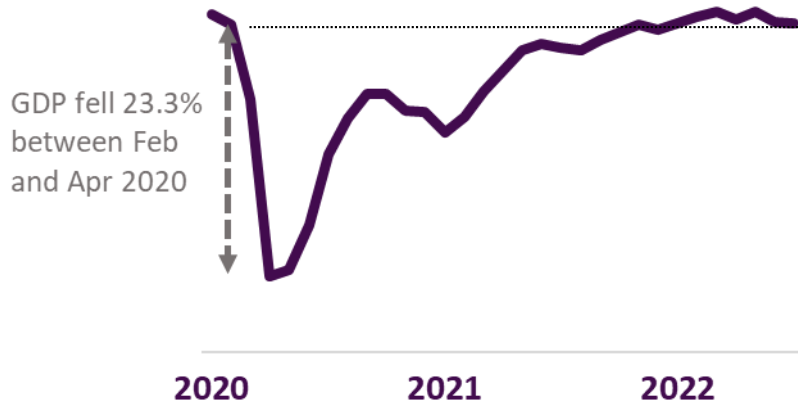
Monthly GDP

In July, Scotland's onshore GDP fell by 0.2%, after the fall of 0.8% in June and growth of 0.7% in May.

In monthly terms, output is now 0.1% above the pre-pandemic level in February 2020.

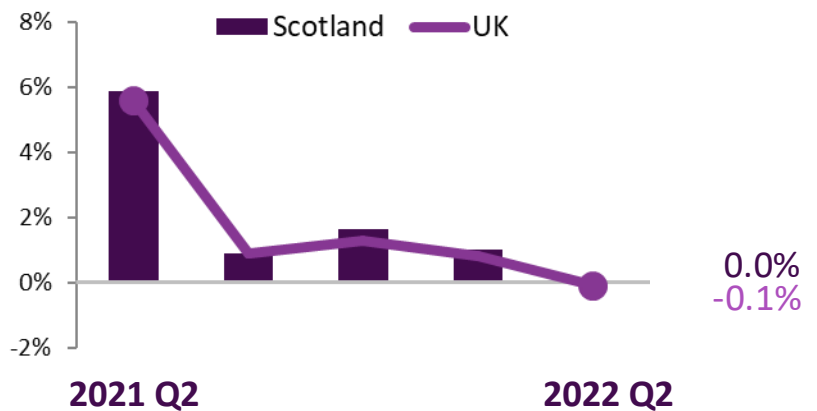
Quarterly GDP

In 2022 Quarter 2 (Apr-Jun), Scotland's onshore GDP is estimated to have been flat (0.0% growth), slowing from 1.0% growth in Quarter 1.

GDP for the UK as a whole fell by 0.1% during the same period.

Change in GDP compared to the previous quarter



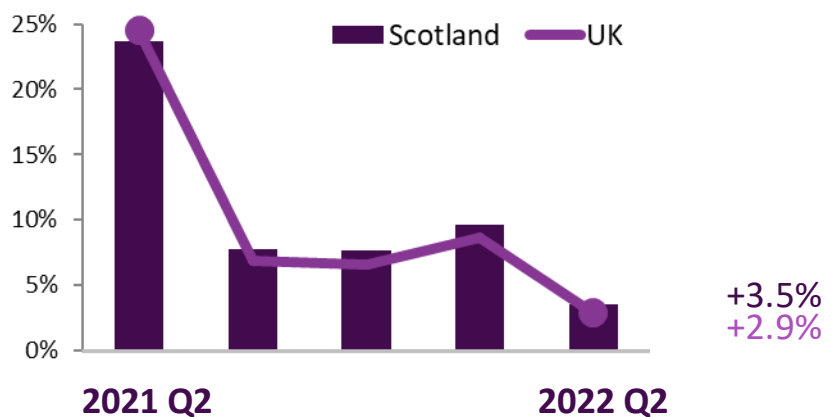
GDP over the year

Compared to 2021 Quarter 1, Scotland's onshore GDP has increased by 3.5%. This measure is now slowing after the initial recovery from the large falls in GDP during 2020 and 2021 Q1.

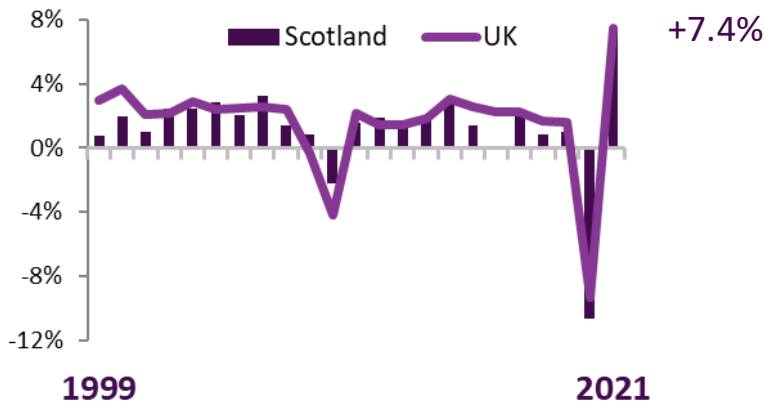
GDP for the UK as a whole increased by 2.9% over the year.

Change in GDP compared to the previous year



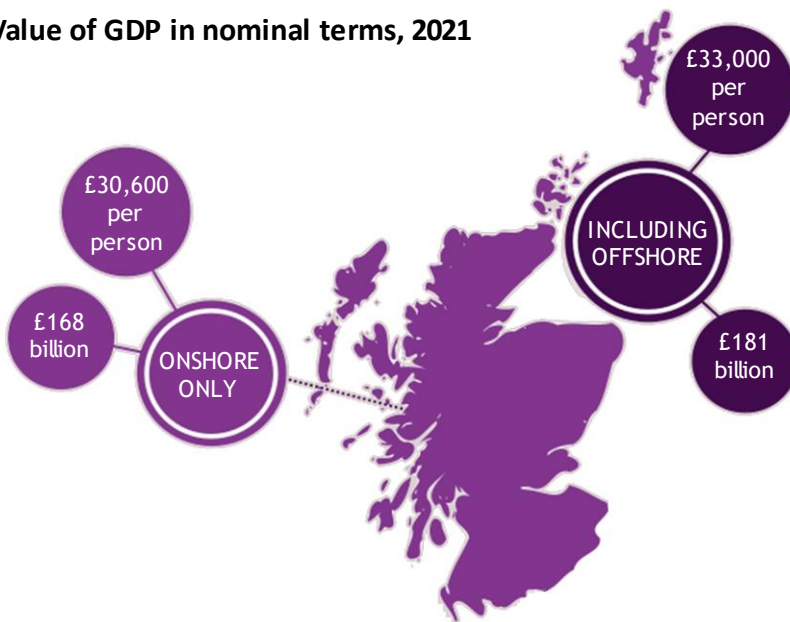
Annual GDP Growth

In 2021, Scotland's annual onshore GDP grew by 7.4% in real terms. This follows the fall of 10.6% in 2020 when the economy was severely disrupted by the COVID-19 pandemic.

Annual GDP for the UK as a whole grew by 7.4% in 2021.

Annual GDP Value

In 2021, Scotland's onshore GDP is estimated at £168 billion in total, or around £30,600 per person. Including offshore oil and gas, Scottish GDP is estimated at £181 billion, or £33,000 per person.

In 2021, nominal GDP for the UK as a whole is estimated at £34,300 per person.
