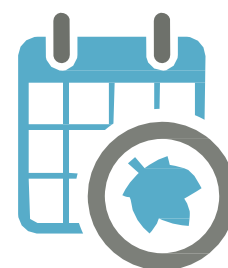

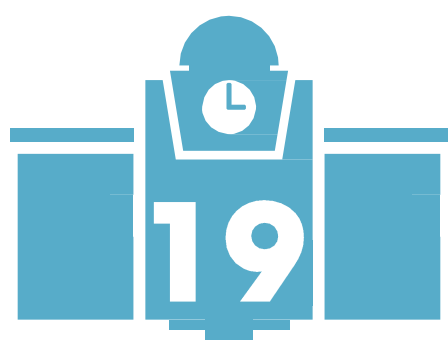
INFORMATION SHEET 2013

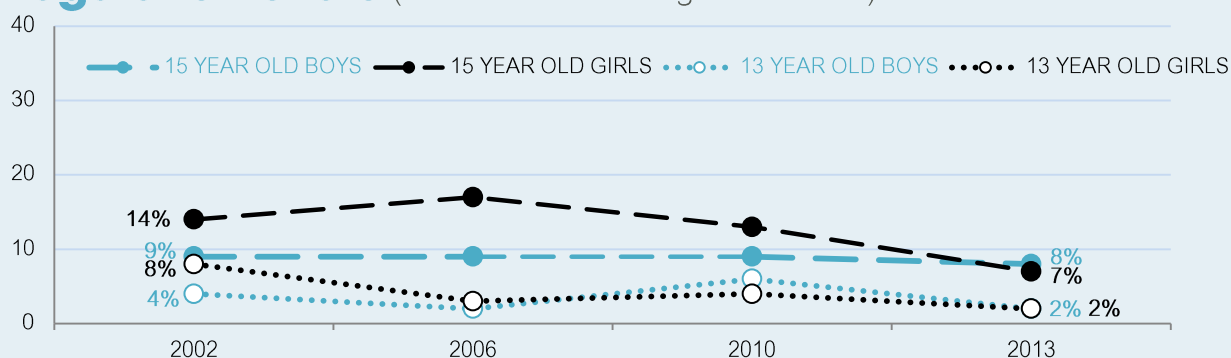

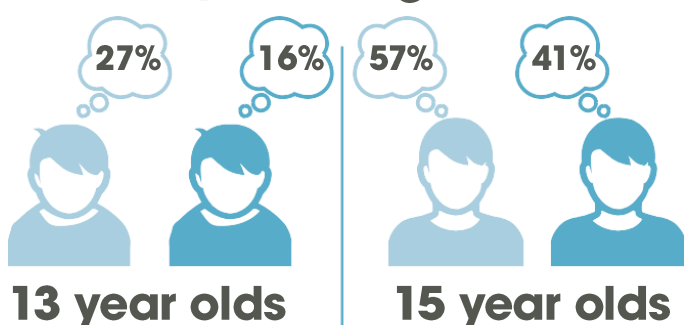

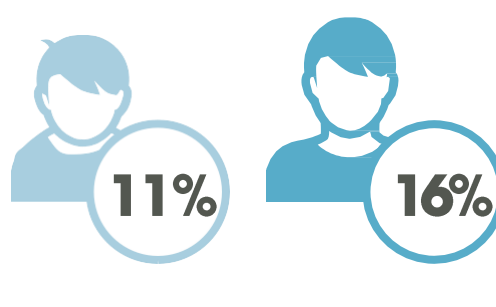
## % regular smokers (smoke at least one cigarette a week)



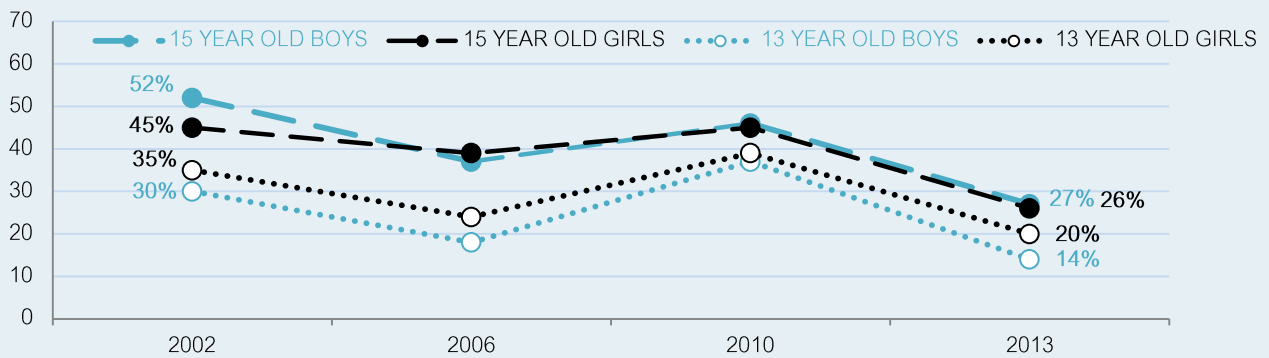
## % who think it is ok to try smoking



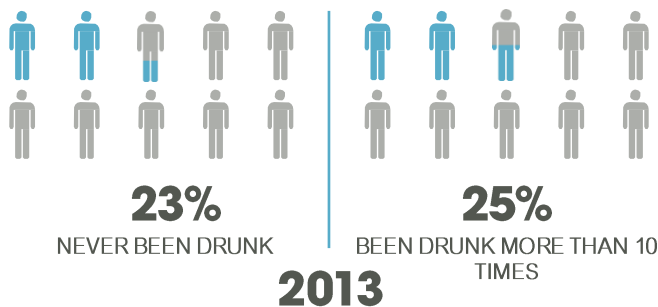
## % who have ever tried an e-cigarette, even once



## % who drank alcohol in the last week



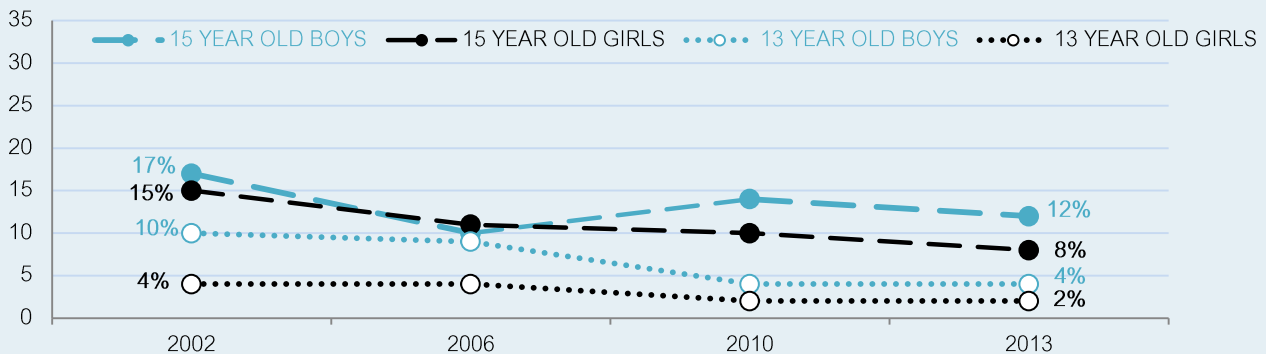
## % of 15 year olds, who have ever had a drink, who have...



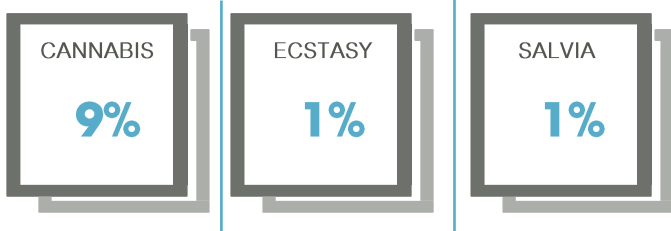
## Effects of drinking alcohol



## % who used drugs in the last month

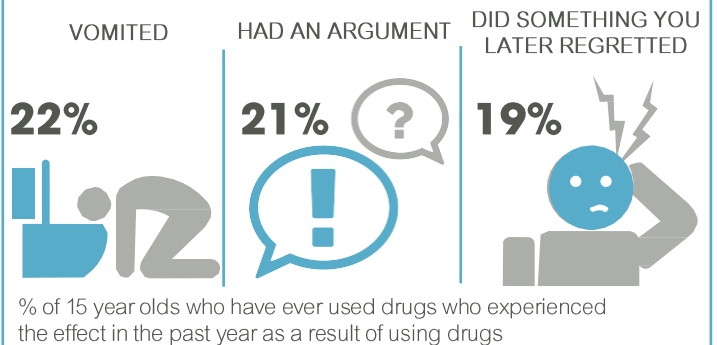


## 3 most commonly used drugs in the last month

## Effects of drug use



A regular smoker is defined as someone who smokes at least one cigarette a week. Results are based on a self-completion survey of 3,493 S2 and S4 pupils. Fieldwork was conducted between September 2013 and March 2014. Data are weighted by local authority, year group, sex, school denomination, school sector and area type (i.e. urban/rural) using the Scottish Government's pupils census data, independent schools data and urban/rural classification.
