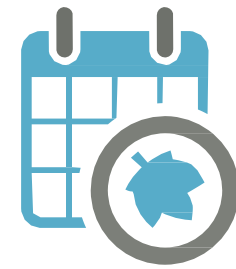

Next wave providing **local authority level** data will be in **Autumn 2017**



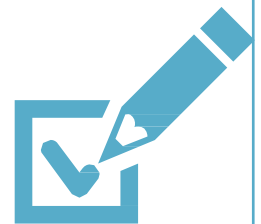

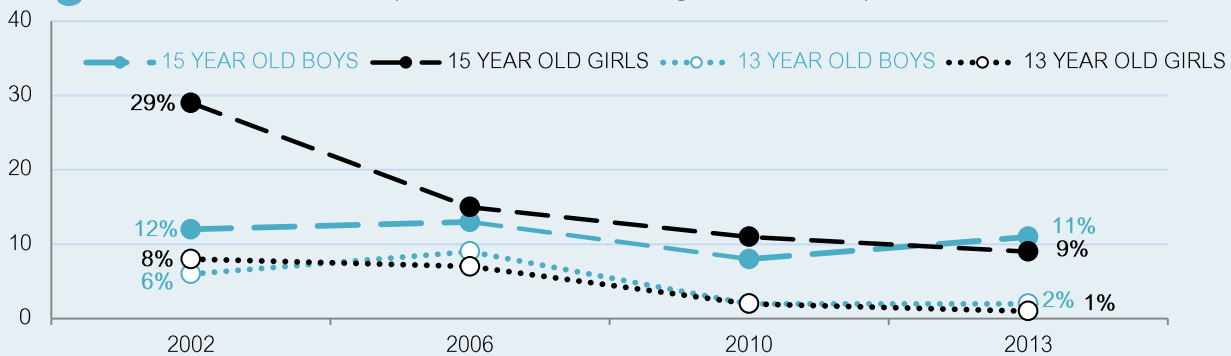

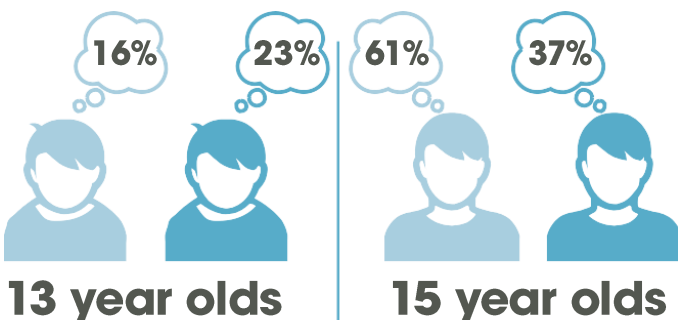


% regular smokers (smoke at least one cigarette a week)

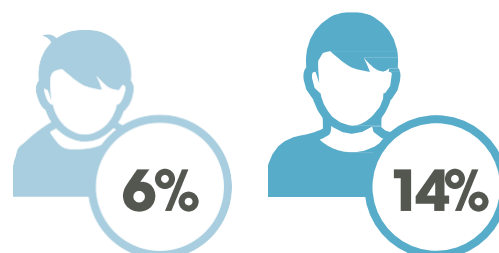


% who think it is ok to try smoking

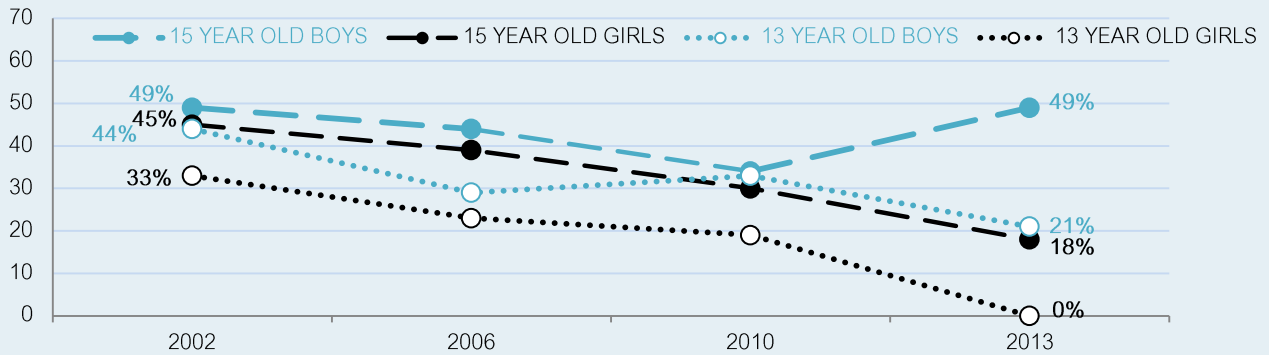
% who have ever tried an e-cigarette, even once



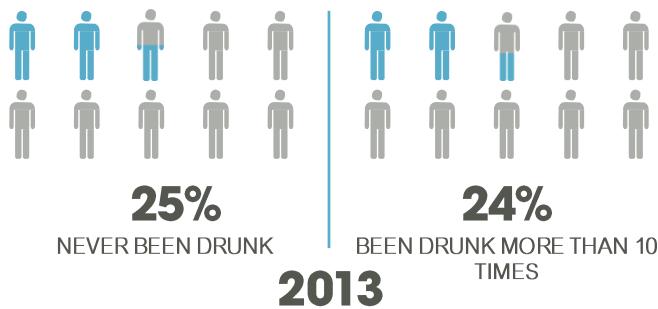

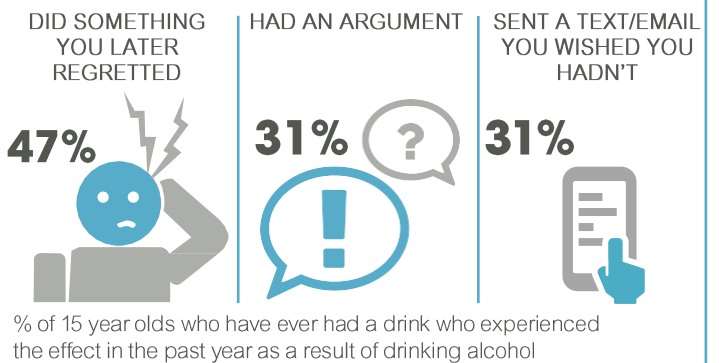
% who drank alcohol in the last week



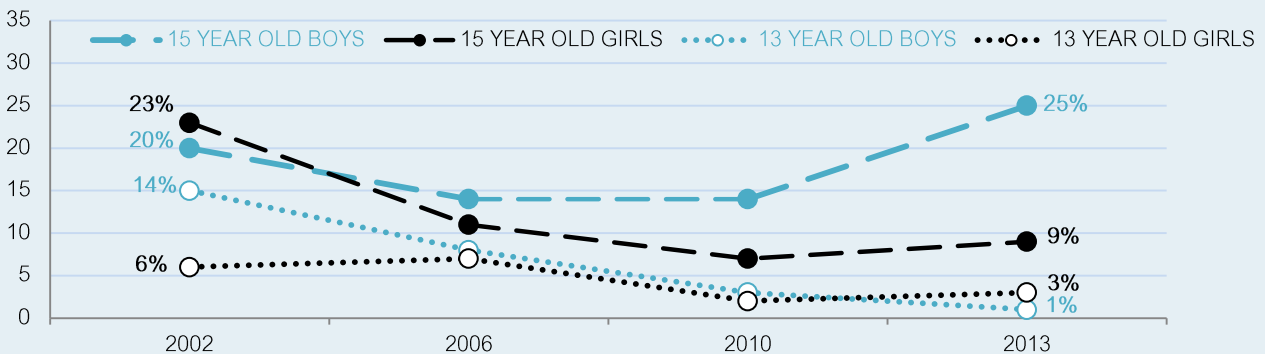
% of 15 year olds, who have ever had a drink, who have...



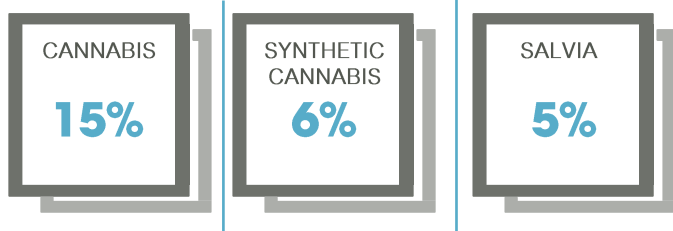
Effects of drinking alcohol
