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1. Official Name of Board

NHSScotland Effective Prescribing Programme Board (EPPB)

2. **Purpose of Board**

The Programme Board will manage the Effective Prescribing Programme and make recommendations to the Sustainability & Value Programme Board and NHS Boards Chief Executives' Group.

Proving recommendations and implementation guidance to relevant stakeholder groups

The Programme Board represents senior clinical leadership and senior management across NHSScotland and has been established to drive the programme forward and ensure delivery of the outcomes and benefits while minimising risk.

The Programme Board considers feedback from the public in the form of input from the Public Partners.

Role and Remit of Board 3.

The Board will define, agree and own the vision for the NHSScotland Effective Prescribing Programme. The Board is ultimately accountable for ensuring that the programme and projects are delivered to achieve the required outcomes. The Programme Board will provide clinical leadership and an increased focus to:

- Accelerate the pace of change
- Remove barriers
- Ensure national spread

The New Opportunities Group has been setup as a mechanism for identifying opportunities which support these programme objectives.

The Programme Board is responsible for:

- Defining an ambitious vision for the NHSScotland Effective Prescribing Programme
- Providing professional leadership and expertise to shape and guide the development of the NHSScotland Effective Prescribing Programme
- Ensuring the ongoing overall alignment of the NHSScotland Effective Prescribing Programme with the broader medicines policy context, national efficiency initiatives and strategic direction of NHSScotland
- Providing an increased focus on existing initiatives contributing to the vision; adding pace to achieving the benefits and ensuring spread across NHSScotland
- Owning and being accountable for the delivery of programme outcomes to realise the vision
- Resolving strategic and directional issues between projects
- Establishment of robust management control and organisational governance
- Defining the acceptable risk profile and risk thresholds for the programme and its constituent projects
- Owning the resolution of programme risks and issues and removing barriers
- Defining the scope of services to be considered and the agreement of work-packages, associated plans and deliverables at programme level
- Ensuring the programme delivers within its agreed boundaries
- Assuring the integrity of benefit profiles and realisation plan
- Board Members understanding and managing the impact of change for their representative area.
- Enabling the making of resources available for planning and delivery purposes
- Reporting progress to NHS Board Chief Executives' Group and the S&VP Board.
- Prioritisation of projects and initiatives within the scope of Effective Prescribing

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
