Sorry to get in touch out of the blue, but I was wondering if you might be available for a quick conversation about a beaver issue at some point today or tomorrow?

Trees for Life has been looking into the idea of beavers in the Highlands and how this might be made to work in partnership with land managers. Part of this work has been to survey a small beaver presence on the River Glass near Beaully and this has very recently led to the discovery of a family with kits.

While the presence of beavers is known locally, we think the fact that there is breeding is only known to ourselves at present. Given what we know about the current situation on the Tay, we've assumed this will be a tricky issue for SNH and yourselves. I met with SNH yesterday and proposed a solution that might work well for all parties. They were interested in this and are considering that further but I was hoping there might be an opportunity to discuss it directly with yourself.
