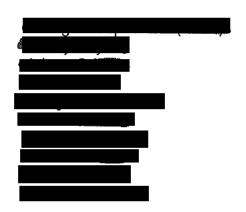

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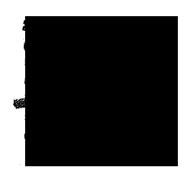

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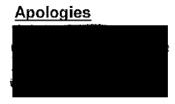

1. Welcome and introductions

Chair) welcomed everyone to the MAPPA Development Meeting and provided an overview on proceedings to the floor, the main elements highlighted were Terms of reference, MAPPA Guidance, Risk practice training, ViSOR usage and future ongoing development of MAPPA.

2. Terms of reference and feedback

Draft Terms of reference document issued on 14 January 2016 was discussed and agreed that reference should be made to ongoing development and continued efficiency of MAPPA. It was also highlighted that areas of the recent Thematic may also feature within future discussions.

MAPPA Development Group will be seen as a sub group of the Tripartite and minutes will be provided to Tripartite members.

Action 1: Minor amendment to be made to Terms of Reference as discussed and circulated to group

- MAPPA Extension implementation date 31st March 2016.
- In next 4 weeks all SOG's will receive a presentation on MAPPA Extension
- An action plan would be created to address ViSOR usage with CJSW and partner agencies which would also assist in delivery of HMIC(S) Recommendation 7.

4. MAPPA Guidance

provided an update on progress of MAPPA Guidance to ensure readiness for introduction of MAPPA Extension. The guidance has a slightly new format addressing each of the categories in separate chapters. It was acknowledged that this update is purely to reflect the MAPPA Extension and there will be a further review of the Guidance in the coming months to address areas highlighted in the HMIC(S) MAPPA Thematic Inspection.

provided suggestions for the Disclosure chapter to include Keeping Children Safe and Domestic Abuse Disclosure. also highlighted that there was work ongoing in relation to Victim Notification Scheme within Restricted Patients and whether or not this should be included.

Action 4: to update disclosure chapter and include PSOS SOP once approved. Liaise with Restricted Patients Branch to obtain information on VNS

requested that RMA re-visit the Risk assessment Chapter to ascertain if it is fit for purpose. Advised that he had been working on this along with a couple of wording changes to the document set which had been identified at the recent Risk Practice Training.

Action 5: to provide update on Risk chapter for Guidance

Action 6: Group to provide any other comments/amendments for the guidance by next meeting (17/02/2016) ALL advised that he has submitted the SPS chapter and a future meeting will take and to go over ensure it covers all aspects of extension Action 7: Meeting to be arranged with SPS to finalise chapter reported that RMP requirements have been submitted in relation to LSCMI system. It is intended by colleagues in Community Justice that a Change Board will oversee future development and agree priorities for changes to the system. suggested that as co-ordinators and Chairs become more familiar with the document set (including the RMP) that it would be useful to consider this forum's role in reviewing MAPPA priorities to feed into the Change Board. Action 8: Include LSCMI as a future agenda item Chair The group raised the issue of housing for MAPPA Extension and that the NASSO clearly deals with REGSO. This requires further development, however should be mentioned within the guidance for consideration on a case by case basis. Action 9: Inclusion of paragraph in MAPPA Guidance regarding housing for new category. requested that clarity is given around the wording for the exit of these risk of serious harm offenders and future management. Action 10: Consider the wording for exit of these offenders to ensure all agencies are aware of future management asked if the guidance covered those offenders who would transfer from England and Wales. SG advised that the same process would apply as currently applies to offenders managed under MAPPA.

5. Risk Practice Training

updated that the RMA have delivered 7 Risk Practice Training Courses to Criminal justice Social Work covering 31 local authorities

There are courses planned for February to May and will ensure adequate social workers are trained in the application of ROSH throughout the country.

At the end of each course, participants are asked evaluate the quality, relevance and impact of the training by completing a questionnaire. In addition, to measure learning gain, participants are asked to complete a pre and post course knowledge check.

To date course evaluations have demonstrated positive outcomes across the 7 courses delivered.

- Based on data from the post course questionnaire:
- 98% of participants agreed or strongly agreed that the material covered enhanced their knowledge and understanding of risk assessment and management practice
- 94% of participants agreed or strongly agreed that the course has equipped them to undertake an assessment of risk of serious harm and build a risk management plan
- 94% of participants agreed or strongly agreed that the skills they have learnt are relevant and easily transferrable to their workplace
- 96% agreed or strongly agreed that they would recommend this training to others

The RMA has drawn up proposals for continued evaluation and quality assurance regarding the use of the training in practice.

The RMA would like to evaluate the effectiveness of the training and its impact on practice and to consider any implications for the revision of the training provision, or indeed, standards and guidelines. To do this the RMA would like to examine the extent to which the training results in the production of risk assessments and risk management plans that are useful and meet the agreed standards of practice.

Action 11: to keep group updated on progress of evaluation proposals
asked about Chairs and Coordinator's training as these persons would play a pivotal role in the delivery of the extension. advised that dates and locations had been scheduled agreed but there required to be a resource available to coordinate same. Indicated that the RMA had originally proposed undertaking this but were asked to review the funding bid. As a result it was confirmed by Community Justice colleagues that this would be undertaken by TDOs. agreed to forward on this communication to and and as so that this issue should be resolved as soon as possible.
Action 12: Action 12: to liaise with and to confirm responsibilities for co-ordinating Chairs training.
reported that the police risk practice training had commenced with all OMU officers from Constable up to and including Inspectors being trained in the forthcoming months. 8 courses will be delivered prior to 31st March 2016.
highlighted that CJSW are the lead agency for the MAPPA Extension offenders. The role of police in the management of these offenders will be different to what is currently being delivered by police in respect of RSO's. The police have no legislative basis or powers in respect of MAPPA Extension offenders unless there are additional civil orders in place. Given the nature of these offenders and the

potential requirement for a 24/7 response then responsibility for assisting CJSW in managing these offenders within the community will be the responsibility of Local Policing under the command of Local Area Commanders. Local Policing will be supported by the OMU with regards to specialist assistance when required with regard to risk assessments etc. Local Policing will ensure information sharing with partners within MAPPA and will target any criminality evident by these offenders. Given the role of Local Policing there is no requirement for them to undertake the specialised Police Risk Practice training.

An officer from the NOMU and one from a local OMU have been identified to shadow the police training in order to ensure future delivery of the training.

6. ViSOR

SG updated the group on the ViSOR Risk Escalation Case which has been approved (awaiting sign off by SIRO) and ViSOR terminals can now be re-located to allow for better access within CJSW offices.

Police Scotland supply the network facility and they will require to apply their own security assessment to ensure this meets the needs of risk mitigation policies. They will be looking to pilot in 3 Local Authority areas (rural/urban and semi-rural) to overcome any continuing access issues.

SG spoke about toggling and that currently is progressing work within Fife to see if this can be achievable in the future and identify relevant costing.

Action 13: All ViSOR related issues / concerns to be pulled together and compilation of an action plan to effectively address ongoing and future ViSOR progress with all partner agencies.

SG provided an update in relation to Vetting which is NPPV2 and there will be no change to this in the foreseeable future. SG has pulled together a vetting leaflet providing and explanation of vetting and the procedure involved. This has gone before Social Work Standing Committee for approval prior to circulation.

Where there is a vetting fail for Police Scotland have the final decision if a staff member is successful in clearance to use ViSOR.

Action 14: SG to re-visit leaflet in relation to appeal and include line manager involvement.

asked if refresher training was still taking place in the absence of vetting and SG acknowledged that this was still being offered to CJSW staff.

updated that the draft VISOR minimum standards has been sent to Social Work Standing Committee for approval prior to onward circulation.

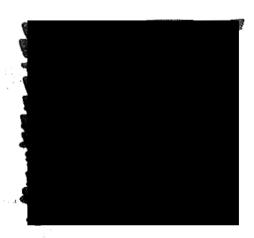

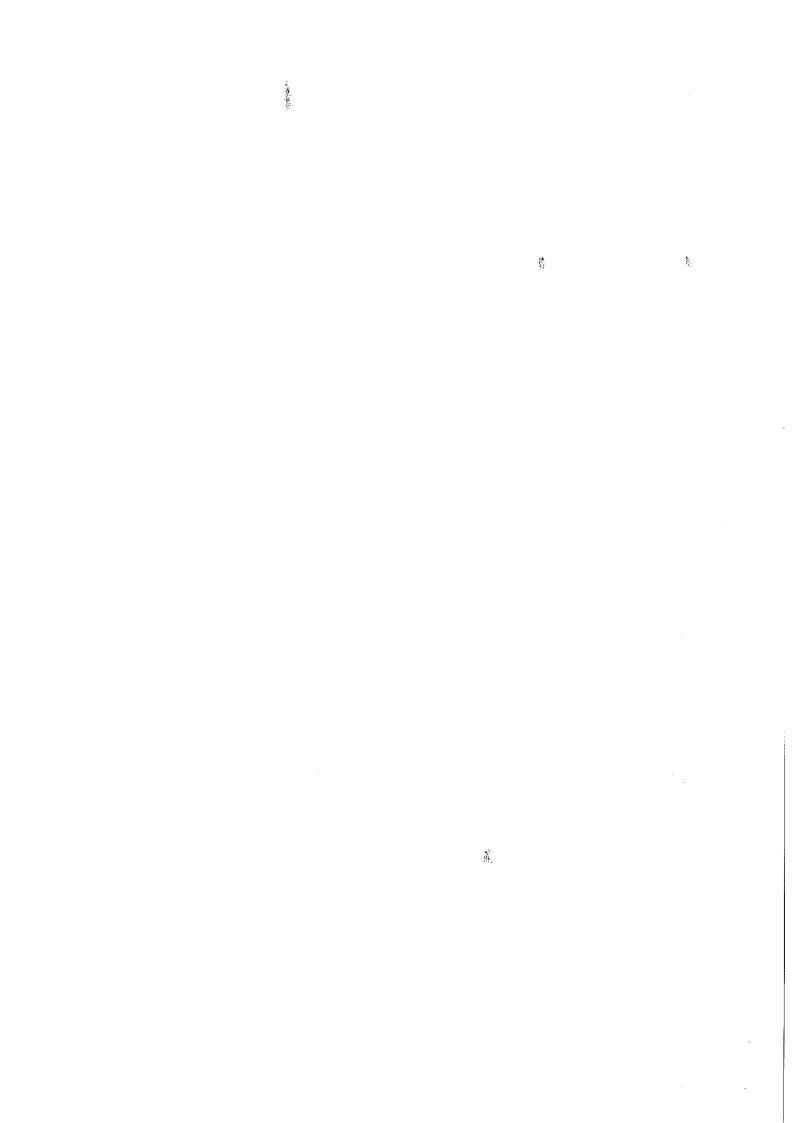
