Therefore we will need to explore this early next week, when we plan to return with a BBC cameraman.

The photo op/visit element would have to be in the Informatics building which is a short walk away. This could be a visit to the Valykrie robot which I am told will eventually be a Mars probe, so probably gives us the right look and feel in terms or research and development, investment in universities, STEM, international collaboration etc.

Given that we don't know for definite that this venue will work I think it would be wise if you could explore alternative options in case this isn't suitable.
