Saheliya also received £137,000 from the Third Sector Early Intervention Fund during 2013–15 for work with minority ethnic young women on forced marriage, honour based violence and FGM.

In addition the Scottish Legal Aid Board (SLAB) provides funding to the Scottish Women's Rights Centre Legal Project who provide legal advice to victims of gender based violence, including on legal options where there is risk of or incidents of female genital mutilation. This project has been funded by SLAB since March 2015.

Legal Services Agency led the project partnership with Rape Crisis Scotland from March 2015 – September 2017. From October 2017 – March 2018 the project has been led by Rape Crisis Scotland in partnership with JustRight Scotland.

The project delivers and improves access to legal advice & assistance and representation, in relation to civil matters, for women affected by gender based violence including civil legal advice and representation and related advocacy support for women affected by gender based violence. The project provides regular quarterly reporting to SLAB. In the period since March 2015, the project reports that it has provided second tier legal advice relating to FGM on one occasion.

In addition to the funding provided by SLAB, funding of £172,000 (2016-18) has been provided to the Scottish Women's Rights Centre to expand the capacity of the Centre. This funding has been provided from the £20m Violence Against Women and Girls Justice Fund (2015-18) announced by the First Minister in March 2015.
