Dear AC member



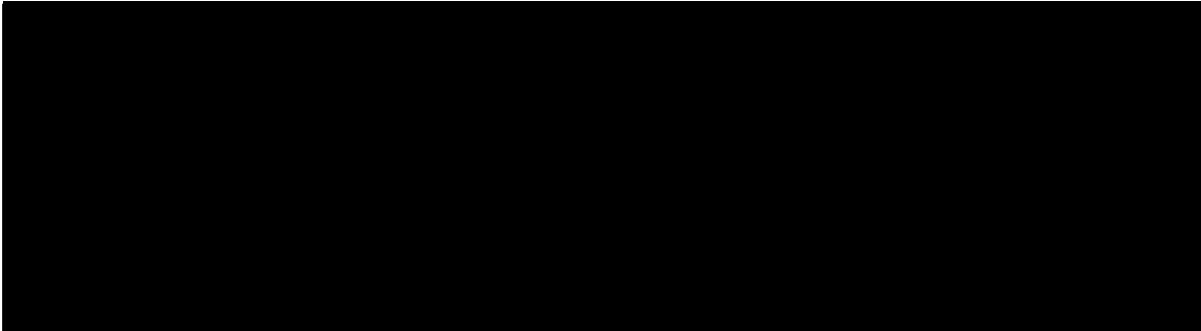
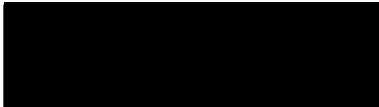
