The Scoping report has been submitted now and should be available online soon (unless you already got a copy from your colleagues). This approach is applied consistently across all of the topics in the Scoping Report - I appreciate this is quite 'scenario specific' but once the overall approach is understood and accepted by MS-LOT in their Scoping Opinion it can form the basis of an EIA which focusses only on the significant issues and allows for timely and robust determination.

The approach has been to include the conditions from the old/ existing consent as 'embedded mitigation' in this assessment. In this case the changes to WTG numbers/ dimensions don't affect the requirement for mitigation- an RMS to be approved by Scottish Ministers and them implemented before wind farm operation. By accepting a requirements to develop and implement mitigation (to the satisfaction of Scottish Ministers- in consultation with MOD) the residual impacts are not likely to have significant effect and should be scoped out of the EIA. The Original ES concluded residual effects to be not significant and is not consider design changes would alter this conclusion.

The details of the mitigation proposed in the RMS may vary depending on a range of variables like WTG dimensions, MOD requirements, removal of RAF base at Lechers, presence of other wind farms, etc. We propose that efforts and discussion should, therefore, not be on (re)establishing the presence/ absence of clutter on the ATC at Leuchars but instead pursuing an RMS which is proportionate and meets the requirements of all parties.

We envisage MOD will be consulted on the scoping report and it's possible that their views on Leuchars RMS could be sought at this stage of the EIA process (rather than just in the ES). This approach allows MOD to be engaged in the formal process earlier, SG may seek clarification and possibly reassessment of issues at Leuchars which will help inform the Scoping Opinion and align the RMS with this outcome. Hopefully DIO are able to represent the most current MOD approach and position on the risks at Leuchars Station- this could be complementary to the parallel discussions with DE&S, BEIS and SG.

Very happy to hear your views on this and we can discuss one to one or with the wider group whenever suits.

I suppose the questions that arises is: are the impacts, issues and mitigation the same, given that turbine heights will change? We know the issue at heart and the temporary mitigation is agreed and the same. We can guess that the impacts are also broadly the same but will MoD be consulted on that?

It therefore might be appropriate to scope it out of any requirement for a further assessment to be undertaken, if you are happy that is not required, but not scope the issue out of the ES. If the MoD need to be consulted, the way to do that is through the ES so we think it would need to be in there in some form that allows that.

SCOPING OPINION REQUEST FOR PROPOSED SECTION 36 APPLICATION AND MARINE LICENCES APPLICATIONS FOR INCH CAPE OFFSHORE WIND FARM AND ASSOCIATED OFFSHORE TRANSMISSION WORKS, OFF THE ANGUS COASTLINE

Inch Cape Offshore Limited (ICOL) have formally requested, in accordance with Regulation 7 of The Electricity Works (Environmental Impact Assessment) (Scotland) Regulations 2000 (as amended), (herein referred to as 'The Electricity Works') and Regulation 13 and Schedule 4 of The Marine Works (Environmental Impact Assessment) Regulations 2007 (as amended), (herein referred to as 'The Marine Works') a scoping opinion for the above proposal.

In 2014 ICOL gained consents for the construction and operation of the Inch Cape Offshore Wind Farm and associated OfTW, the consents are currently the subject of a Judicial Review. In parallel with the Judicial Review, ICOL is progressing the development of an offshore wind farm and associated offshore transmission works, described in the Scoping Report as the 'Revised Development'. The Revised Development is being developed to take advantage of advancements in offshore wind technology to achieve ICOL's twin objectives of improving project economics while reducing associated environmental effects. This has resulted in a significant reduction in turbine numbers and associated infrastructure.

The Revised Development will consist of an array of up to 72 turbines. The period of consent to be sought for the array is up to 50 years.

Under Regulation 7 of The Electricity Works and Schedule 4 of The Marine Works, Scottish Ministers are required to consult the specified statutory bodies (and other interested parties) as to their views on the information which ought to be provided in the Environmental Statement.

Paragraph 94 of the Scottish Government Planning Circular 3/2011 states that while every Environmental Statement should provide a full factual description of the development, the emphasis of Schedule 4 of The Electricity Works is on the 'main' or 'significant' environmental effects to which a development is likely to give rise. In many cases, only a few of the effects are of significance and require discussion in the Environmental Statement in any great depth. Other impacts may be of little or no significance for the particular development in question, and will need only very brief consideration, to indicate that their possible relevance has been considered.

As the Revised Development is broadly analogous to the Original Development, in terms of location and most aspects of its design, ICOL has adopted a particular approach to scoping. The Scoping Report sets out ICOL's intention to maximise, where appropriate, the use of existing data and the conclusions of the EIA for the Original Development in the EIA for the Revised Development. This approach is intended to focus the Revised Development EIA on those potential impacts that are most likely to give rise to significant effects (or where uncertainty exists in relation to the validity of the previous assessments) and thereby avoid revisiting assessments where the conclusions reached previously in the Environmental Statement for the Original Development can be shown to be applicable to the Revised Development through the scoping process.

To assist the preparation of the Environmental Statement in this respect, we ask that you clearly indicate where you agree or disagree on those aspects to be scoped in or out of further assessment. **It will assist Marine Scotland in providing the scoping opinion if particular attention is paid to the questions asked by ICOL in the scoping report where relevant to your area of interest.**

You should note that your comments will be used to instruct the developer on what should be in the Environmental Statement, and also help them comply with the guidance in the [Scottish Planning Policy \(SPP\)](#) and [the National Marine Plan \(NMP\)](#). Therefore, the clearer your comments the more likely that the requirements will be met. You should also state which heading this information should be provided under in the Environmental Statement.

The ultimate aim of the scoping exercise, as discussed in [Planning Advice Note 1/2013: Environmental Impact Assessment \(PAN 1/2013\)](#), is to assist the developer in identifying the key environmental issues surrounding this proposal. Scottish Ministers achieve this aim by drawing on the knowledge of local authorities and consultees alike through the formal consultation process. However, PAN 1/2013 also states that the scoping exercise should give an early indication of where mitigation measures may be necessary. As required by The Electricity Works and The Marine Works, developers must provide a description of measures to prevent, reduce and where possible offset any significant adverse effects on the environment, in their Environmental Statement. To ensure the Environmental Statement includes this key section, consultees must highlight in their responses any areas where mitigation measures should be addressed. In tandem with the prioritising of environmental issues, this will allow Scottish Ministers to provide developers with a full and accurate opinion of what should be included in the Environmental Statement.
