I am writing to advise you of action being taken in light of a report submitted to the Scottish Government by Waverley Care on 24 May regarding concerns they had about how an award made to them through the Scottish Government's International Development Fund was deployed. The issue specifically raised with us related to the sum of £18,232 paid by Waverley Care to EHAP for aids prevention work.

Today we have instructed Waverley Care to commission an independent audit to investigate EHAP's conduct in the proper discharge of funding entrusted to their care.

We have also notified the three other donors of EHAP mentioned in Waverley Care's report of this action. We have asked those other donors if they wish to be involved in this audit, and also invited them to share with us any reports of audits they have undertaken at Ekwendeni Hospital in the last 12 months.

Please note we have asked Waverley Care to report back to us by 31 July 2013. Once we have received the completed audit and report from Waverley Care we will consider what further action may be required by us as funders and by them as grant holders. If there are wider lessons to be learned or actions to be taken, we will of course ensure those are applied.

We consider that there is a shared goal and common objective amongst all those concerned about these matters, in relation to establishing the situation, and pursuing all appropriate action.

Many thanks for this and congratulations to you and [REDACTED] for the clean sheet.

In replying to this reminded me of a matter which came to my mind a few weeks ago which I wanted to follow up with you. [REDACTED], sent an extract of a report which had been compiled following an investigation into the use of funds in projects in and around Ekwendeni Hospital. This report makes serious allegations about how funds sent for particular purposes would appear to have been misappropriated and diverted for other uses. I am not aware of the status of this report or its veracity and what has happened to it since its publication. However, I understand that it was prepared for a charity with projects in Malawi supported with SG funding.

Firstly I am wondering if you are aware of this report and, secondly, if you are, do you know the reaction of the SG to it? The allegations made and the scale of the apparent misappropriation are extremely serious so much so that I am assuming that the SG are taking the matter similarly seriously. I appreciate that, from what I have read, this report has no direct relevance to the SMP but my concern is the reaction of the SG with, given the seriousness of the matter, the possibility of an over-reaction in which organisations such as ours and even some of our Members with SG funded "projects" in Malawi begin to be subjected to a higher level of scrutiny than to date. I am not concerned so much with the level of scrutiny as the danger of the SG perceiving the funding of projects in Malawi as a greater risk than previously considered and act accordingly, which is not good as we begin to prepare the funding application for 2014/2017.

As a [REDACTED] I am really asking if you are aware of the possibility of the risk of collateral damage to the SMP arising from this whole matter and thus be an issue for the Board at its next meeting?

I have no knowledge of whether any of that is true and, even if it is, of whether those circumstances could have influenced her findings – but I pass it along as a piece of context which you may find helpful. Our partners in CCAP are content that the allegations are without foundation and the Church of Scotland intends therefore to continue its funding.

Of course, we remain concerned that the allegations may indeed have some basis in fact and I hope you will be prepared to share any problems you may uncover.

I hope this helps. Do just contact me if I can help in any other way (although I am on leave from this evening until 5 August).

Your report indicated some concerns about a grant you awarded for £18,232. Your report concluded that EHAP may not have carried out all the activities Waverley Care funded it to deliver. Your report also proposed that an independent audit is undertaken to investigate EHAP's conduct in discharging their responsibilities for this money.

We accept your proposed way forward. Please now take action and press ahead immediately to commission an independent audit of EHAP's use of Waverley Care's funds.
