## Narrowing down of the scope:

then went back and asked the FOI'r Mr to narrow the scope of his request as it would cover all and everything that SG has ever filed on SG. Mr responded by clarifying that:

I am especially interested in international development work and funding that has been given for this purpose. The current issues with Oxfam go back to programmes in and around 2006, so I would like details of funding going back to this period. I appreciate copies of correspondence etc would be difficult to retrieve for this entire time period but key documents (e.g. grant confirmations, or letters with details of grant given) would suffice.

Very specifically I am requesting in point (4) below for information relating to the Scottish Government's response to the current Oxfam situation, so I would hope this would include a broader range of documents, particularly since this only refers to the last few weeks, ie:

 Details of briefings, emails or notes of meetings by Scottish Government Ministers or officials relating to Oxfam, including correspondence with Oxfam by Scottish Government Ministers or officials, since the investigation into Oxfam's project in Haiti was published in the Times newspaper on 9th February 2018.

## What the ID Team has done to date:

- Narrowed the scope of the request
- Collated in all relevant documents, and redacted most of them, these are all in the erdm file and marked redacted

## What is now to be done

- 1. Redact the documents not yet done not a huge number those below in the zip folder that has provided where she says "had to file the zip file in eRDM. These documents are the ones I've identified as being in scope. These documents have still to be redacted and the PDF documents highlighted and sent with the others to in the Scanning Unit". (the scanning unit can help)
- 2. Proofread/look with a fresh eye at what has already been redacted and just make sure nothing else.

- 4. Also need Ministerial clearance to issue.



Please note that Katy as the relevant SpAd is in China, so someone else will need to look at this. Please apologise to them for the fact that we have been over a week coming back to them on this.
