Background

The upper cost limit exemption was applied to the original request as many parts of the information asked for would have required an organisation wide trawl, with subsequent review and a likely requirement for redaction as the request related to commercial third parties.

The original decision has been upheld with modification. The modification being more explanation has been given around the why the upper cost limit would have been exceeded.

A data subject request has also been identified which relates to the final point of information requested (at the end of Annex A in PDF doc) because it is personal information, of which the requester is the data subject, and so it is subject to the Data Protection Act 1998 (DPA).

This review does not need additional clearance from SpAds or Private Office and can be issued once you have approved.
