Timing and context of visit

1. You arrive in Brussels on 28 January and will give a presentation in Scotland House on 29 January. Scotland Europa invited you to give that presentation as part of a discussion series in Scotland House. For copy recipients' information, details of that presentation are attached. This visit will take place as we move into phase 2 of the discussions about the UK withdrawal from the EU.
