Further to our recent discussions about corporate governance I am attaching the agreed remit, terms of reference, fimelines and methodology. John Brown, Chair, NHS Greater Glasgow and Clyde and Susan Walsh, Non Executive Director, Healthcare Improvement Scotland will work with you and the board. This follows your request for the involvement of experienced non executive colleagues from other boards to provide some support. Their biographies are provided in the annex of the attached paper.
