SA said that the Council's role would be coming to an end once the exclusion zone had been reduced. She described as "unfair" the criticism of the Council that it had prioritised the needs of the Art School over those of local businesses and residents: in fact the Council had insisted that the GSA start work at the Dalhousie Street end of the Mackintosh Building in order to help residents, rather than the Reid Building end as GSA had wanted. The Council would provide updated briefing to SG officials. AO'D described the working between SG and Council officials as having been really positive, and suggested that this might be built on by interchange or work-shadowing arrangements.
