

I would highlight that it's the applicant's responsibly is to ensure that the information submitted to support a CAGS claim is accurate and is in accordance with the work carried out.

Additional condition 1 highlighted in red on the CAGS8a approval stipulates that "An accurate fence line measure must be submitted at each claim stage".

On the CAGS approval this condition is further expanded upon with the words "and quantify the materials used when submitting with your claim".

The invoice raised by Scotfast Ltd dated 27/01/19 is for £59,024.90 The claimed amount submitted is for £51,511.70 which is the same figure as approved in the CAGS8a conditions of contract dated 23<sup>rd</sup> October 2018. Prior to payment to the contractor and to the submission of the CAGS claim and I would expect members of the common grazings committee to satisfy themselves that contract has been carried out to an acceptable standard, in accordance with the CAGS8a approval and contractors quote.

The findings of our inspection are as follows.

The fence was inspected on 8<sup>th</sup> July 2019 and surveyed using metre accurate GPS equipment.

Total length of new fence 3962.50m, length claimed 4174.00m. 211.50m overclaim.

Supply of materials for new fence @ £2.23/m x 3962.50 = £8836.38. Supply labour to carryout installation of new fence @ £5.00/m x 3962.50m = £19812.50

Carryout fence line bundles for notes, stack materials in 100m bundles and helicopter on site @ £1.60/m x 3962.50m = £6340.00

25no Strainers @ £18.00ea = £450.00

Install 25no strainers @ £17.00ea = £425.00

8no turners (60 claimed) @ £13.00ea = £104.00

Install 8no Turners ( 60no claimed) @ £17.00ea = £136.00

Notes from Inspection and already provided on photographs —68 no rails used as fencing/posts supports, 107 used for under-fill, 13 used as pegs.

Strainers/turner posts, two seen left lying un-used on hill.

No steel posts used in any rocky areas along length of fence.

The fence at time of inspection lacked stability and was shaking in some parts, not meeting SGRPID standards as a stockproof fence.

From information provided and payments made, the applicant would appear to have overpaid the contractor for materials unused and associated labour on a fence surveyed as being 211.50m shorter than approved and claimed.


