Dear Ash,

It was good meeting you and your colleagues last week. Unfortunately, we did not get a chance to talk in more detail about your plans for Scotland, and the work that I, as the National Rapporteur on Trafficking, do to monitor and evaluate the situation regarding prostitution and all forms of trafficking in human beings in and to Sweden. I have been invited several times to Scotland with a few of my colleagues, including Ms. Gunilla S.Ekberg, whom you may have met, and am keen to know more about the work that you do to prevent and combat prostitution and trafficking in human beings. If it is of interest to you, I would like to suggest that we schedule a phone conversation at a time that is convenient for you.

I am in the process of publishing my 20th annual report on the situation in Sweden, which as always will be translated into English. I will make sure that you receive a copy. In the meantime, the attached overview of the situation in Sweden from 2018 may be useful. An updated version will be published during the autumn of 2019.
