I attach my most recent report on the situation in FMEL with Ferries 801 and 802. It speaks for itself but the cash flow challenge has produced, at least, a 3 month slip to the programme. The current significant uncertainties mean that it is not possible to produce a revised programme now. As these are resolved a new programme will be produced and I recommend a further review in late January. I have briefed Frances Pacitti, by telephone, on the main findings of this report.

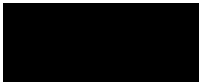
