In terms of the SNH action points -

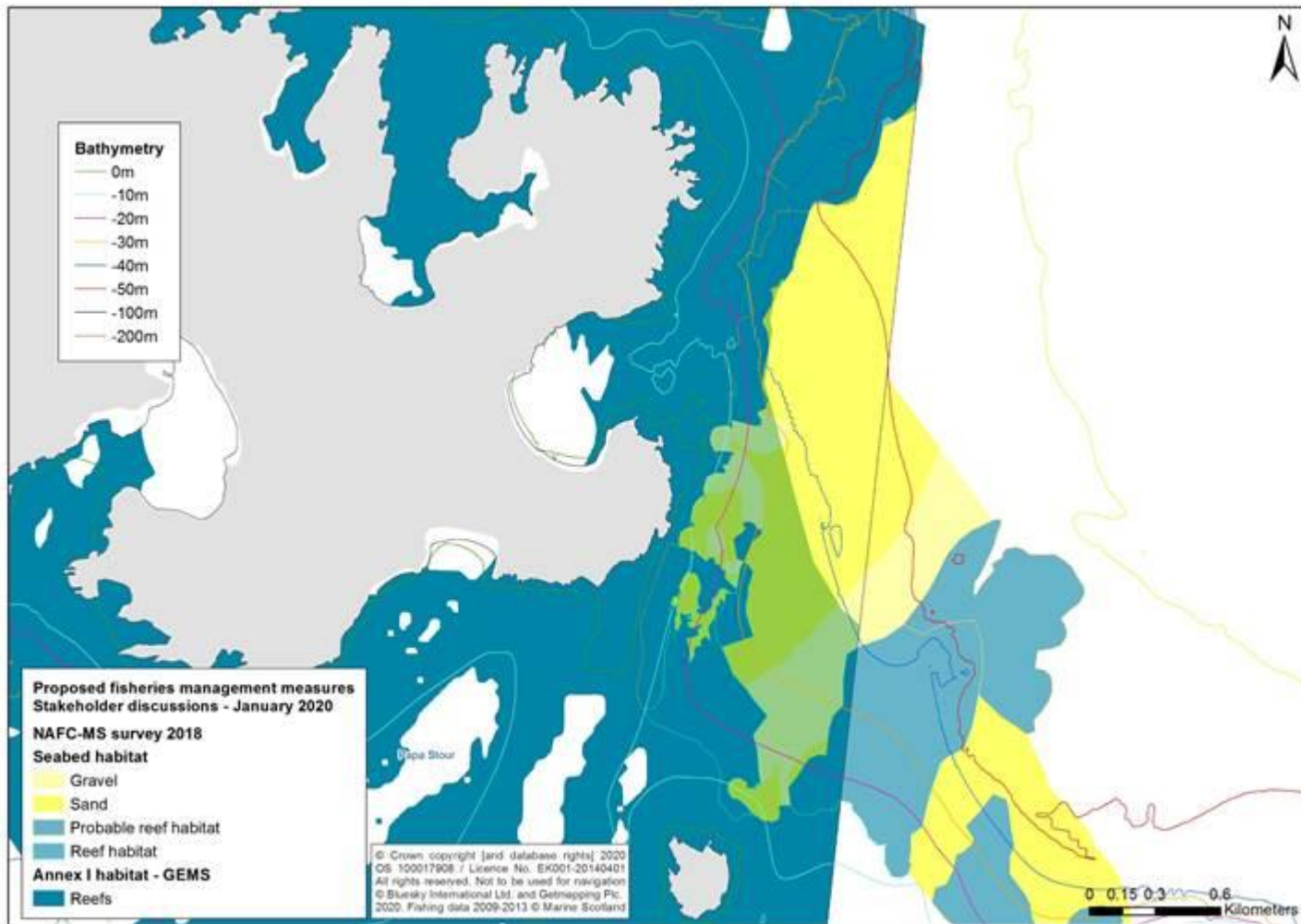

Sorry for the flurry of e-mithers today. Last one before the weekend ...

- SNH committed to send through amended polygons for Annex I reef habitat on the east coast of the Papa Stour SAC.
- MS commissioned NAFC survey work here in 2018
- REDACTED has amended the relevant layers in GEMS and the updated version is available via our DAM at - <https://media.nature.scot/record/~82b9197975>
- Let me know if this is a pain and I can move to the FTP instead
- The changes should reflect the map below - basically some additional sediment habitat where formerly mapped as reef.
- We discussed the likely need for some buffering which might close off the smaller pockets of sediment (SSMO obviously want small buffers)
- [REDACTED] / [REDACTED] can then liaise with SSMO about evidence of fishing activity in this area to inform decisions re: whether possible to leave an area open
