Good Morning.

I have read your comments in a National newspaper regarding your activities towards the end of September. I note that you describe your behaviour as a "blip", that Coronavirus "makes you act out of character" and that you claim "regulations and guidelines have changed and have been so muddled".

Earlier this year, you, quite rightly, criticised the behaviour of Dominic Cummings

Despite being suspended from your Party and receiving widespread opprobrium, you have declined to resign as MP for Rutherglen and Hamilton West. As a mere tax payer who has scrupulously followed the rules and guidelines since March, I would make the following observations about your actions:-

Presumably, your decision to remain an MP is based on some deep seated principle that your behaviour does not warrant your resignation. I assume that you will be foregoing the £3,000 pay increase as a modest reflection of public disquiet?

Your comment about regulations and guidelines being "muddled" may hold water if you were a member of the public. However, you have been an MP for 5 years and you are suggesting that you were unaware of and/or confused about COVID regulations. If that is true, how are the general public supposed to understand and follow them, if a Member of our Parliament doesn't understand? Essentially, the basics are fairly easy to understand. If you feel unwell, quarantine. Do not put others at risk. Full stop, end of story.

To describe your behaviour as a "blip" is borderline offensive. Your actions, quite possibly, prejudiced the welfare and safety of others. Hardly a blip.

If you are correct that the Virus makes you act out of character and that you lose the ability to think straight, does that absolve any of the general population from acting responsibly and to consider their fellow citizens if they catch this appalling Virus? Just consider how Students could react if they follow your lead. "Yes, I contracted the Virus but I wasn't thinking straight so I continued to socialise and infect others. Very sorry". If I was to take mind altering drugs, could I use your defence if I then went onto commit criminal activities or anti social behaviour?

In my opinion, you, Cummings and Jenrick help to undermine the Public's willingness to follow COVID regulations. Cummings has remained in his Job as has Jenrick and now, you. You're not in very auspicious company.

You'll be upset to know that I'm signing off now. As a recent retiree, I've now reached the age when I'm "not thinking straight". As a result, I'm going to infect other people.....with my views about politicians and Government advisors disobeying their own rules.



I have just read about your party member who, having received a positive coronavirus test, got on a long distance train.
