Applications to the Rapid Research in [COVID-19 Programme²](#) were submitted by Scottish Research Institutions following an open, competitive and wide-ranging call for research on COVID-19. The applications, which included a justification for each research project, the methods that would be followed, and the estimated costs, were subject to independent expert review with funding decisions on projects based on the views of experts from an independent panel that included expertise in medical, public health, health and care, and social research. The [outcome³](#) was a total of 56 research projects led by a total of 15 research institutions across Scotland.
