

REASONS FOR NOT PROVIDING INFORMATION

Personal data relating to third party

An exception under regulation 11(2) of the EIRs applies to some of the information you have requested. Reg 11(2) (Personal data relating to third party).

An exception under regulation 11(2) of the EIRs (personal information) applies to some the information requested because it is personal data of a third party (names and contact information) and disclosing it would contravene the data protection principles in Article 5(1) of the General Data Protection Regulation and in section 34(1) of the Data Protection Act 2018. This exception is not subject to the 'public interest test', so we are not required to consider if the public interest in disclosing the information outweighs the public interest in applying the exception.

Scottish Forestry does not have the information

Under the terms of the exception at regulation 10(4)(a) of the EIRs (information not held), Scottish Forestry is not required to provide information which it does not have. There is no report concerning the designation of the land therefore Scottish Forestry does not hold a copy.
