Thank you for your email below, I am responding on behalf of my colleague {redacted} who is currently on leave. I am sorry for the delay in responding we were awaiting clarification from the council. I have spoken to East Renfrewshire council today who have confirmed that the correspondence received by you is not an enforcement /amenity notice as such that can be appealed to DPEA. A planning authority may take enforcement action if it thinks that development or action has been carried out without the required planning permission or where a person has failed to comply with a condition attached to a permission. For this, a planning authority must serve an enforcement/amenity notice on you and I understand that is not yet the case.

I am afraid therefore there appears to be no right of appeal in this instance and I can only advise that you go back to the council and discuss the next steps with them. I understand {redacted} was the contact at the time.

I am sorry I could not give you a more favourable response but trust this clarifies the position.
