I am writing to formally report to ADSFB the possible misreporting of sea lice data by The Scottish Salmon Company (TSSC) at Meall Mhor marine cage fish farm on Loch Fyne.

I received intelligence from someone associated with the salmon farm that sea lice numbers may not be being reported in accordance with the relevant act (Section 2 of the Aquaculture and Fisheries (Scotland) Act 2007).

I attended the site on 24 April 2021, between the hours of 09:00 and 20:00hrs. This can be verified by Police Scotland who were in attendance.

I gathered extensive drone and underwater footage during this time. 30% of stocked cages were surveyed underwater. All were surveyed from the air. All footage is time, date and location stamped to a legally acceptable standard. I subsequently asked for an independent assessment of the underwater footage. This was provided by a trained employee of another salmon farming company. This was to confirm species of sea lice present, life stages, numbers of females and whether or not the levels of infestation were commensurate with previous counts reported by TSSC for the salmon farm.

This individual confirmed the sea lice present were Leps (and so should be counted for the purposes of reporting weekly sea lice numbers), were present in high numbers at all life stages, with significant numbers of gravid and non gravid females and that the numbers observed were significantly in excess of that which the sea lice counts being previously reported would suggest.

The sea lice counts reported by TSSC for this salmon farm under the new weekly sea lice reporting regime are as follows:

- Week 13: 1.09
- Week 14: 0
- Week 15: 0.07
- Week 16: 0.1

My footage was collected at the end of Week 16 and so is relevant only to the claimed figure of 0.1 gravid/non gravid female leps sea lice per fish reported for that week.

The images and footage which I have supplied below, show much higher levels of the relevant sea lice. While some sea lice are very obvious in the head area, many require a degree of experience to identify. However, almost every fish shows tell-tale signs of mobiles and adults behind the dorsal and adipose fins, revealed by white scarring. Indeed it is almost impossible to find a fish in the footage that doesn't have multiple gravid females present. This is in stark contrast to a sea lice count which equates to no more than a single gravid/non gravid female sea lice per 10 fish.

While individual images can face the accusation of being selective, this is overcome by the raw footage, of which there is nearly 60mins and thousands of fish. This can ultimately be viewed frame by frame in high resolution and sea lice counted on individual fish.

You will be aware that this is a critical time of year for wild salmon with the migration of wild salmon smolts taking place in Loch Fyne. I would hope you are aware that there are a number of late cycle salmon farms in Loch Fyne, which present the highest potential risk of elevated sea lice numbers.

It is my understanding that Fishery Boards and Trusts have asserted their desire and ability to police sea lice numbers on salmon farms.

Please could you let me know what action you will take to verify sea lice numbers on this salmon farm? Do let me know if there is any information you are lacking to begin your work?

If the sea lice levels are in fact in breach of those set out in the code of practice for this time of year, will ADSFB and FMS be requesting a reduction in sea lice levels by the salmon farm? What is an acceptable sea lice level for this farm?

Has any sampling of wild fish been undertaken in Loch Fyne this year, given the number of late cycle salmon farms, to establish the loading on wild fish populations? I can't think of a location where absolute sea lice numbers could be higher in a single water body in Argyll at the moment.

I would add that there is a degree of urgency required given the risk being posed to wild salmon as we speak.



- Mortality records: if I could get the last 4 full weeks (starting w/b 19 April) the daily mortality count by cage, as well as a total weekly percentage & count, and then from 10/03/2020 until 18/04/2021 just a weekly count and a weekly percentage for the whole site please, if there are any cleaner fish on site I will require to see the mortality for the cleaner fish as well.
- Medicine records: complete records of all treatments from current back to 10/03/2020
- Sea Lice Records: I have attached a pdf copy of the enhance sea lice questions. Those will be the questions I will go through with you. If you could

have a look at them and let me know if you have any more questions beforehand. Please note that a lot of these questions require document evidence.
