The rapid rise in the number of people advised to self-isolate by the app in June was in line with the rise in the number of positive test cases.

\*\*On the 1 July at 9pm, the National Contact Tracing Centre advised that contact tracers would no longer contact all identified positive cases and ask them to enter their test codes into the Protect Scotland app and that an automated SMS message would be sent to all positive test cases asking them to enter the test code provided if they are app users. This has produced a significant rise in the number of contacts being directly advised by the app to self-isolate despite the falling number of positive test cases since the peak value of 4,234 on the 1 July.
