**COP26**

On COP26, the First Minister said plans are progressing well and we were live to the challenges of Covid. The First Minister said we were working to deliver a safe, successful COP26 in Glasgow this November and want to be able to hold this in-person, noting that decision making on this rests with the UN. As hosts, the First Minister stressed we recognise how urgently the world must come together to agree action to tackle climate change. An in-person COP would facilitate the tough discussions that are necessary in order for us to deliver the aims of the Paris agreement. As highlighted in the recently released 6<sup>th</sup> Assessment IPCC report, global warming has now reached around 1.1°C above pre-industrial levels and is already affecting every region across the globe, and even with aggressive mitigation – it is more likely than not that we will reach 1.5°C of global warming by the early 2030s. This means COP26 in Glasgow is an even more significant milestone globally which must act as a decisive moment for the world to deliver a global deal that supports the goals of the Paris Agreement and delivers lasting action towards a Net Zero future - in a way that is fair and just.

Devolved, state and regional governments have a critical role in the fight against climate change and meeting the goals of the Paris Agreement. However, at present, the potential capacity of state and regional governments globally to tackle climate change is neither fully realised – too few states and regions are committing to and acting on Net Zero, nor fully recognised and supported by national governments or the multilateral system. Releasing this potential could help achieve the goals of the Paris Agreement to mitigate greenhouse gas emissions, and adapt to an already changing climate. The Scottish Government is committed to playing our full part to ensure that COP26 delivers a positive outcome that increases the ambition and action needed by governments at all levels to deliver the global transition to net zero in a way that is fair and just. A key part of this will be using our position as European Co-Chair of the Under2 Coalition – a role held by Scotland’s First Minister – to raise the ambition and galvanise action of state and regional governments ahead of, at and beyond COP26.

It is clear that states and regions will play a major role in the fight against climate change and will need to collaborate effectively to share knowledge and experience to increase climate ambitions globally. Networks already exist to provide platforms we can unite behind, including: The US Climate Alliance, C40, ICLEI, Regions4 and the Under2 Coalition. **[REDACTED – SECTION 30(b)(ii)]**

Role of multilevel action – (convening of the convenors)

Achieving the goals of the Paris Agreement must be a truly international and collaborative endeavour – with networks such as Regions4, C40 and the Under2 Coalition having a crucial role to play in driving forward collective climate action from all levels of government around the world. To ensure these networks are all pushing in the same direction and unite behind a common – and ambitious – goal presenting states and regions as a strong force committed to action at COP26, **[REDACTED – SECTION 30(b)(ii)]**

States and regions have shown their desire and ambition to not only find innovative ways to fight climate change but also raise their ambition. However, states and regions face a number of challenges that block/slow down their paths to Net Zero. **[REDACTED – SECTION 30(b)(ii)]**

Ahead of COP26 the UN High Level Champion has launched the global Race to Zero campaign, designed to galvanise action and commitments to net zero from multiple different global stakeholder groups.
