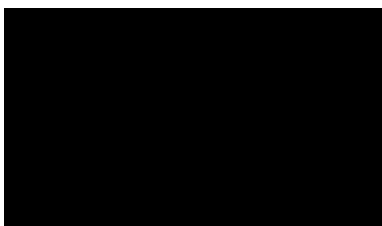
Authorisation of Non-Prescribed Traffic Signs

M8 ACTIVELY MANAGED HARD SHOULDER – M9 JUNCTION TO M8 JUNCTION 1 HERMISTON ROUNDABOUT

The Scottish Ministers, in exercise of the powers conferred upon them by sections 64 and 65 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and of all other powers enabling them in that behalf; hereby:-

1. Authorise the erection and use at or within 5 metres of the site(s) shown on the attached plan(s) marked Transport Scotland Plan No **NPS/2/M8/M9/2020/1/1-4** for the use of signs conforming as to size colour and character with that shown on the attached drawing(s) marked Transport Scotland Plan No **NPS/2/M8/M9/2020/1/5&6** hereinafter referred to as “the authorised sign”.
2. Illumination of the authorised signs shall comply with regulation 8 of the Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 2016 [unless exempted elsewhere in the Regulations in relation to a particular sign].
3. Direct that it is a condition of this authorisation that the erection and use of the authorised sign(s) shall continue to have effect only until such day as may be appointed by Scottish Ministers in writing to the relevant authority for the removal or alteration of the authorised sign(s) and on that day the said authorisation shall without prejudice to the giving of any further authorisation or direction cease to have effect.
