SG / SGP Cooperation Agreement & Manifesto Commitments

The cooperation Agreement between the Scottish Government and the Scottish Green Party has now been agreed by both parties and the Shared Policy Programme includes a number of commitments relevant to aquaculture. It includes a commitment to develop Highly Protected Marine Areas (HPMAs) covering at least 10% of Scotland seas, the detail of these areas is yet to be developed.

Specific to aquaculture the Programme states that the Scottish Government will:

- reform the regulatory and planning framework, starting with an **independent review** to consider the effectiveness and efficiency of the current regime and make recommendations for further work by the end of 2021.
- develop a **vision and strategy** for sustainable aquaculture that places an enhanced emphasis on environmental protection and community benefits.
- begin an immediate programme of work to better protect wildlife and the environment, including a **response to the Salmon Interactions Working Group** in September 2021, consultation on a spatially adaptive sea lice risk assessment framework for fish farms by the end of the year, and strengthened controls on sea lice, wrasse and fish escapes in the course of 2021/22.
- **explore** how best to ensure that **fish farming contributes more** to support communities and recreational fisheries, to promote innovation and to support services such as fish health and welfare inspections and monitoring.

Morning All

Does anyone have time for a quick discussion prior to the Directors group meeting? I met with the SSPO, FMS and SIWG chair yesterday to discuss the SIWG response as draft. I got a number of comments back and suggestions for change which I am working through. Most relate to drafting.

I was brought back to recommendation 1.14 as an underpinning recommendation which is the basis on which everyone agreed the report and I would value a quick discussion on this if you have time before the Directors meeting. If not, we can possibly discuss during the meeting or hang around after.

1.14 For sites where best scientific evidence indicates that an existing site presents an adverse impact on wild salmonids:

- In the first instance, tighter regulatory standards should apply (see section 2 below);

[amongst others, Trigger levels for sea lice intervention action specific to the farm management area (to be reviewed subject to adaptive management)]

- The consenting regime should be amended to enable efficient relocation of existing biomass to a suitable alternative location, within a spatial planning and area management framework

This relates to Recommendation 53 of the salmon farming inquiries;

RECOMMENDATION 53 However, the Committee considers that there should be immediate dialogue with the industry to identify scope for moving existing poorly sited farms. It recommends that this should be led by Marine Scotland and encouraged with appropriate incentives for operators, such as giving favourable consideration towards allowing increased capacity at replacement sites that are known not to be environmentally sensitive. The Committee considers it to be important, however, that there is no deviation from due process in terms of granting approval for replacement sites.

The other thing I would like to touch base on is whether there are any dates in the diary to provide feedback to the sectors yet and if you have a rough date you are working towards with regard to consultation.

I'll issue an invite, but if you can't make it don't worry. I can pick up during or after the meeting.

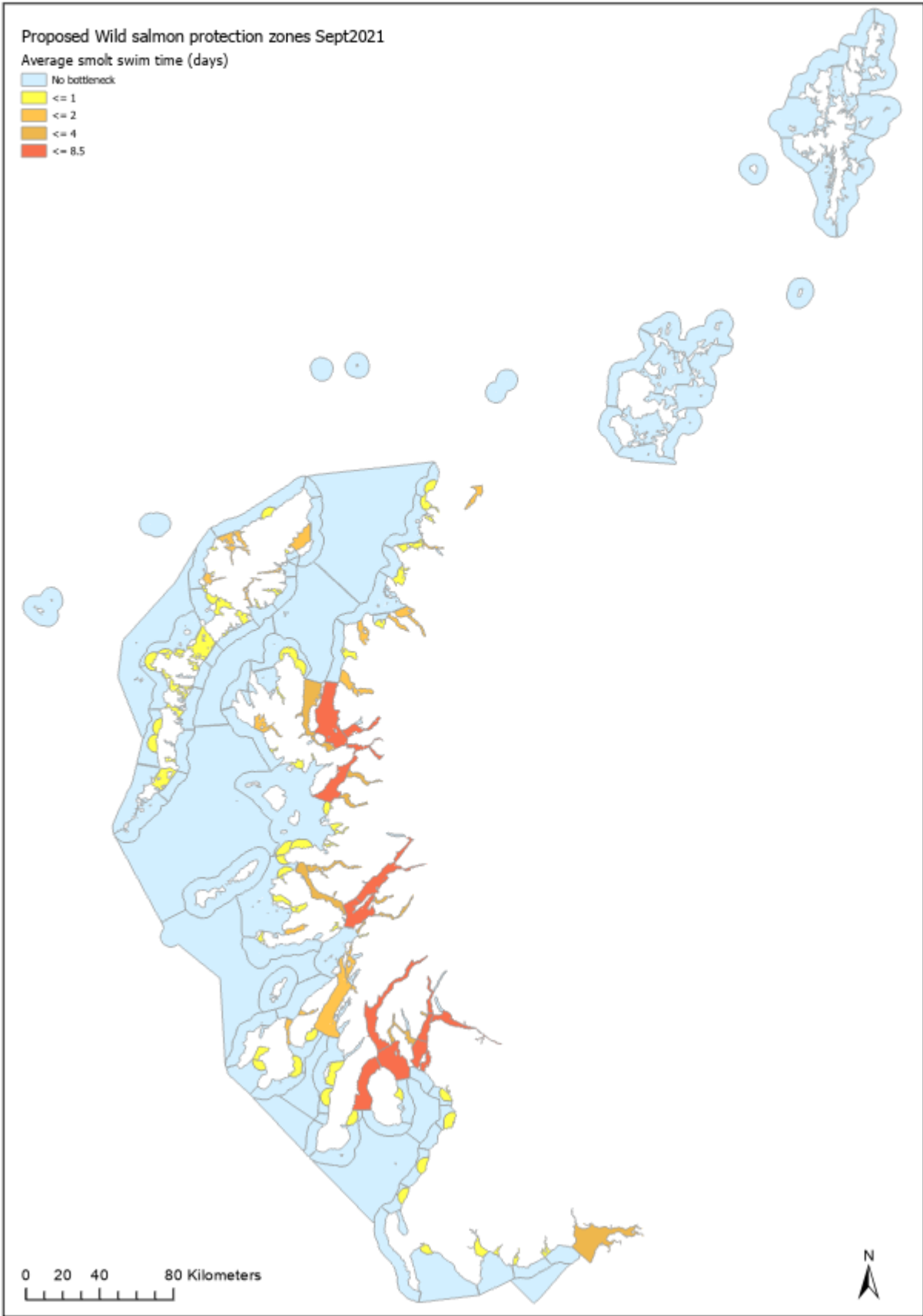

Hi Annabel, Donald,

Just to confirm, SEPA is organising a meeting with the SSPO, BTA, Fisheries Management Scotland and Scottish Environment Link in November. The invite is open to MDs as well as other personnel from finfish producers.

The purposes of the meeting are to:

- Communicate our response to the comments made at the meeting Annabel chaired; submitted to SEPA in writing; and made at a series of one-to-one meetings held in the Spring;
- Check that we have not missed, or misunderstood, any significant comments at this stage.

We will launch our public consultation later in the year. This will open the process to all interested parties as well as providing a further opportunity for those who have been involved so far to provide further comments.

In his email below, Tavish refers to “real-time modelling work”. SEPA has not had any request to furnish SSPO with “real-time modelling”. The framework we are proposing does not involve real-time modelling: As is the case for other finfish farm emissions, finfish farm developers would be expected to provide sea lice dispersion modelling (not real-time) to support permit applications. Modelling protocols for sea lice dispersion modelling will be agreed, post-consultation, as part of the implementation process.

It is worth noting that operators can explore the implications of the proposed framework at locations of interest to them in advance of modelling protocols being formalised. Operators already have their own in-house sea lice dispersion modelling capabilities; are participating in a collaborative sea lice dispersion modelling project with SEPA, Marine Scotland and Crown Estate Scotland; and have access via extensive publications to the latest and world-leading Norwegian modelling approaches. The protocols we agree in the implementation process will reflect these existing approaches.

The SSPO has asked for case study examples. We presented hypothetical case studies to illustrate how the framework would operate in practice, including its adaptive approach, at a workshop held last autumn. The SSPO representative at that workshop, [Redacted – Regulation 11(2)], advised at the end of that workshop that the sector would wish to be engaged closely in a joint implementation process,

including so that it could input into discussions on the modelling protocols finfish developers would use in preparing applications. We are planning just such a joint process.

Different representatives of the SSPO (who were not present in the autumn workshop) have since asked to see case study examples, including in emails yesterday. I confirmed with Tavish (prior to the email below being sent) that I would explore with his team at SSPO what further case studies were of interest to the sector.

First introductions and some background.

[Redacted – Regulation 11(2)] heads up the [Redacted – Regulation 11(2)] in SEPA and is leading on a Sea Lice Risk Assessment Framework that will shortly go out for consultation. The Framework is culmination of about four years of development work with Marine Scotland and extensive discussions with sectors through the Salmon Interactions Working Group, an associated technical group, and a series of working sessions with industry modellers and representatives. I lead on the project for MSS, was a member of the SIWG and technical group and have been heavily involved in the science. There is a broad input from MSS on sea lice ([Redacted – Regulation 11(2)] and his Group), salmon movements ([Redacted – Regulation 11(2)] and his Group), hydrology ([Redacted – Regulation 11(2)] and his Group in [Redacted – Regulation 11(2)] Programme), industry engagement (including [Redacted – Regulation 11(2)]) and review of monitoring methods for sea lice (led by [Redacted – Regulation 11(2)]).

Diarmuid is acting Deputy Director with responsibility for directing Marine Scotland Science, at least until the end of the FY. Diarmuid is leading review and development of science strategy as one of Marine Scotland's priority projects.

This email has two further purpose beyond introductions.

First, for Diarmuid, I have highlighted in yellow on the attached draft consultation document specific references to further work between SEPA and MSS as the Framework is applied. This is a cursory assessment but identifies areas that need to be considered and discussed if they are to be captured effectively in a research strategy (...and I may have missed some). The draft document also provides some background as to what is planned for regulation going forward and will be useful information in advance of a more detailed discussion when you attend my GL meeting next week.
