


Figure 10: Organisation Chart

SCHEDULE 13 - MOTORWAYS PASSES

This page comprises Schedule 13 to the foregoing Contract between the Scottish Ministers and Turner and Townsend Project Management Ltd.

1 Requirements

- 1.1 In recognition of the potential danger of the environment, work on motorways and other high speed roads will generally be undertaken within the protection of traffic management arrangements.
- 1.2 However, in some situations, work off the carriageways of motorways can be undertaken safely without traffic management arrangements. In such situations, the Service Provider shall apply in advance to the Employer for special authority for any persons so to work. Such authority will be given by the Scottish Ministers by the issue of a motorway pass.
- 1.3 The Service Provider shall take responsibility for:
 - training of any of its employees, and any of the employees of its subcontractors, who are to work on motorways,
 - ii) the planning and management of any activity on such motorways, and
 - iii) the actions of such employees when working on such motorways.
- 1.4 All applications from the Service Provider for motorway passes will be made on a standard proforma provided by the Employer. Such requests shall specifically identify:
 - i) the name of the person for whom the application is made,
 - ii) the activity to be undertaken and the section of motorway to which it relates,
 - iii) the start and end dates of the period for which the application is made.
 - iv) the reason why the activity is being proposed without traffic management,
 - v) how the individual shall operate when on the motorway, and
 - vi) the specific training on the health and safety risks that has been given to that person.
- 1.5 Motorway passes issued by the Director allow relaxation under Motorways Traffic (Scotland) Regulations 1995 in accordance with the terms of the application and the pass. The Service Provider will coordinate with the relevant Operating Company to ensure and procure that no other motorway working without traffic management arrangements is undertaken.
- 1.6 All work accessed using a motorway pass shall be planned and logged. The relevant Operating Company and the local police control room shall be informed prior to any such work being undertaken.

SCHEDULE 14 - ENVIRONMENTAL SUSTAINABILITY

1 Introduction

- 1.1 General Requirements
- 1.1.1 The Service Provider will follow the principles of the Scottish Government's and the Employer's requirements for sustainable development.
- 1.1.2 When undertaking any Services, the Service Provider will ensure all of its activities support and contribute towards the Scottish Ministers' objectives and targets for carbon reduction.

2 Requirements for Sustainability

- 2.2.2 The Service Provider shall comply with the requirements of the Carbon Management System in accordance with the guidance contained within the system as amended by the Employer from time to time.

- 2.8 The review of proposed Company's Changes.
- 2.9 Review of Design submissions prepared by the Designer on behalf of the Company.
- 2.10 The checking and reporting on the placing of all insurances and insurance reports (Joint Insurance Cost Report) required under the Agreement including policies and premium payments.
- 2.11 The monitoring and review of the obtaining by the Company of consents and approvals from Relevant Authorities and compliance by the Company with the requirements of interested parties:
- 2.12 The review of requests for assistance in relation to access requirements of the Company for the purposes of carrying out ground investigations;
- 2.13 The monitoring, review and commenting upon where appropriate the studies, surveys, tests and investigations proposed by the Company; PAG 2016 Agreement

- 2.14 Keeping the Company informed with regard to the publication or promotion of Orders or other statutory instruments affecting the Agreement or the
- 2.15 Company's Design;
- 2.16 Liaison with the Company on the publication of any revised Environmental
- 2.17 Assessment Documentation and keeping the Company informed of objections and comments received by the Scottish Ministers;
- 2.18 The monitoring of the implementation of baseline surveys for environmental matters and protective provisions for Third Parties Rights;
- 2.19 Review of arrangements for the operation and maintenance of the existing road.
- 2.20 The review of reports from the Designer on remedial and rectification work and instigation of further tests if considered necessary in accordance with the terms of the Agreement:
- 2.21 The review of the replacement of key staff and if necessary deciding on the requirement for the removal of staff or workpeople of the Company in accordance with the terms of the Agreement;
- 2.22 Carrying out spot checks on the setting-out of the O&MWorks;
- 2.23 The monitoring and the review where appropriate, of returns and records of safety, health and welfare, damage to persons and to property and of the rectification of any loss or damage to any part of the O&M Works;
- 2.24 The receipt of notification of the discovery of any Fossils and Antiquities which become the property of the Scottish Ministers and the issue of instructions to the Company as to the manner of dealing with the same;
- 2.25 Advising the Scottish Ministers of the need for Scottish Ministers action in accordance with Clause 41 [Scottish Ministers Step-In]
- 2.26 Advising the Scottish Ministers of the need for Scottish Ministers action in accordance with Clause 44 [Persistent Breach]
- 2.27 The review of the detailed proposals for inspection and maintenance of the Project.
- 2.28 The monitoring and verification of the Quality System for operation, inspection and maintenance of the Project Road, including but not limited to the part of the Quality Plan for the Management of O&M Works and the part of the
- 2.29 Quality Plan for carrying Out the O&M Works.
- 2.30 Auditing the Company's Quality System including periodic monitoring spot checks and auditing of the Company's quality records.
- Visiting the O&M Site and all offices and depots on predetermined and unannounced visits to monitor that the Operations comply with the terms of the Agreement, including (where this involves joining staff of the Company upon reasonable notice) joining staff of the Company on regular inspections, winter patrols, salting and ploughing operations, etc and taking samples of materials being used for analysis by independent laboratories.
- 2.32 Agreeing appropriate performance indicators with the Company and monitoring subsequent performance.
- 2.33 Carrying out comparisons of the Company's performance with respect to the maintenance of the remainder of Scotland's trunk road network.
- 2.34 Sample inspections of the Company's quality records.
- 2.35 Receiving regular reports from the Company.

- 2.36 Regular and exception reporting to the Scottish Ministers.
- 2.37 Providing recommendations of actions to the Scottish Ministers.
- 2.38 The review and monitoring of any proposals for modification to the Project
- 2.39 Road as a result of O&M Works, Local Authority Works or Developer Works.
- 2.40 The monitoring and spot checking of as-built record drawings for the Operations.
- 2.41 The review of reports on any Defects advised by the Company.
- 2.42 The review and approval of Principal, General and Special Inspection reports for bridges and other structures via the SMS module within AMPS.
- 2.43 Review of the of the 1 year and 3 year Project Reports.
- 2.44 Review of the Company's Communications Strategy, Stakeholder List/Engagement and Press/ Media Releases.
- 2.45 Review of the Company's Winter Service Plan
- 2.46 Review of the Company's Cost Saving proposals and Value for Money review.
- 2.47 Review of land the Company considers surplus to the O&M requirements.
- 2.48 Providing supplier feedback report on the Company.
- 2.49 Reviewing the Company's responses to third party questions/ enquiries including FOI's and providing any additional information.
- 2.50 The review of detailed proposals for inspection of both bridges and 2.51 roadworks and monitoring any remedial works prior to hand-back to the Scottish Ministers.
- 2.52 The co-ordination of arrangements for the hand-back of all Works, Constructional Plant and equipment to the Scottish Ministers at the end of the Project.
- 2.53 Reviewing the Calculation of the Monthly Unitary Charge for the New Roads in accordance with provisions of Schedule 6 of M8 M73 M74 Motorway Improvements DBFO Contract and advising the Scottish Ministers on payment to be made to the Company within such timescales as required by the Scottish Ministers in order to meet their contractual obligations.
