CLASS CONTACT TIME REDUCTION

Purpose

1. To provide an update on implementation plans for the PfG commitment to reduce class contact time (CCT) by 90 minutes per week, over the course of the parliamentary term.

Timing

2. Routine. We are meeting on Tuesday 25 January to discuss.

Background

3. SG has a commitment to reduce CCT by 90 minutes per week. The PfG states this should be done over the course of the parliamentary term. Currently teachers (other than short term supply teachers) have a 35 hour working week. Within that 35 hour week, a maximum of 22.5 hours are currently devoted to class contact (except for those teachers on the National Teacher Induction Scheme, who have separate arrangements).

4. The OECD's 'Education at a Glance 2021' statistics published in September 2021 show that Scottish teachers do more hours of teaching time per year than the OECD average. Teaching time is 855 hours per year in Scotland, compared to an OECD average of 791 in Primary. While teaching time in Scotland is above average, contractual working time is lower than the OECD average across all education levels. More recently also the OECD Curriculum review has recommended that teachers in Scotland should have more time to plan and prepare classes.

5. This issue has been raised in the chamber following your statement on 14 December and in your recent session with the Education and Skills Committee. On both occasions you stated that SG would like to implement this change as quickly as possible, with August 2022 mentioned as possible date to begin a phased

implementation, but that this would be subject to agreement by the SNCT (as the body responsible for terms and conditions for teachers).

Work currently underway

6. The SNCT is currently giving consideration to the implementation of this commitment and the next meeting to discuss this is on 23 March 2022. SNCT changes require to be collectively agreed by all three parties – SG, COSLA and the unions.

Reduced Class Contact Time Analysis – Jan 2022

1. Simple Estimate

Our simple estimate of the number of teachers required to reduce the maximum class contact time I based on a number of broad assumptions. The most important are

- All non-promoted teachers in primary, secondary and special schools currently have the maximum 22.5 hours class contact time. [If this assumption is false less additional teachers will be needed]
- No reduction in class contact time is required for any promoted teachers or peripatetic centrally employed teachers. [If this assumption is false more additional teachers will be needed]
- Timetabling/workforce adjustments can be made so that all teachers. [If this assumption is false more additional teachers will be needed]

2. Additional Teachers

Since the beginning of the pandemic a substantial number of additional teachers have been employed, as the requirement for them to undertake covid recovery roles is reduced there should be opportunities for this additional resource to be utilised to reduce class contact time.

CLASS CONTACT TIME

Background

Manifesto Commitment – Recruit at least 3,500 additional teachers and classroom assistants and *reduce teachers' weekly contact time by an hour and a half to give them the time they need to lift standards.*

The Scottish Negotiating Committee for Teachers (SNCT), as the body responsible for teachers' terms and conditions, are responsible for implementing any changes to class contact time. We have put this issue on the SNCT agenda and will be discussing shortly how this can best be delivered.

EIS 20/20 campaign – At the EIS 2019 AGM a proposal was backed to campaign to reduce teachers' contact time from 22.5 hours per week to 20. The campaign also called for a maximum class size of 20 for "all mainstream classes". In March the EIS launched their Scottish Parliamentary manifesto calling for an expansion of the teaching workforce so that class sizes can be reduced to 20, class contact time reduced to 20 hours per week and to put an end to zero-hours supply lists. EIS believe smaller class sizes would help reduce spread of the virus during the pandemic and also create jobs for many teachers currently unemployed.

Top Lines

- **Reducing class contact time will create additional permanent jobs for teachers, help to reduce teacher workload and enable teachers to have more time to plan their work, aid education recovery and raise standards.**
