Hope you're both well.

I wondered if I could please get an update regarding the IPR and arrange a meeting with yourselves over the coming weeks to discuss a few aspects of this please? I'm aware that a targeted ScotWind Call for Evidence is ongoing and indeed I'm co-ordinating SPR's data submissions to this, but above the project level I would welcome an opportunity to discuss some strategic points:

- IPR Complementarity Review – this was an initial key stage so it would be useful to know if the review has concluded, whether the findings or recommendations are available, and next steps arising from this.
- Sectoral Evidence Group & IPR Steering Group – from previous discussions I'm aware it was intended to convene these as part of the IPR and from discussions with [redacted reg – 11(2)] before [redacted reg – 11(2)] left Scottish Renewables I understand the Steering Group was still to be formed. It would be useful to understand the planned remit/involvement and membership. Please note I'm still the [redacted reg – 11(2)].
- Planned SEA & HRA methodologies, especially in relation to density factors, % coverage and realistic maximum development scenarios.
- Whether an updated SEIA is also being carried out, if so the scope and status of this.
- Planned steps and timescales – from the ScotWind Call for Evidence I note potential slippage as the Information Sheet states the IPR is now due to conclude in Winter (previous Autumn) 2023.

As these are fairly technical points, especially regarding the assessment methodologies, it would probably be best if we could please arrange a brief discussion at a convenient time. My diary is relatively free w/c 14th November if some time would suit?

Good morning all,

I hope this email finds you well.

As you all might be aware the call for evidence closed on the 28th February and we are now reviewing the evidence submitted. Apologies for the delay in contacting you. Since the end of February Marine Scotland has engaged with all ScotWind developers to collect more details on their projects before contacting the Governance groups to ensure we had the most up to date information.

Many thanks to those who have submitted evidence and to the group for sharing the call for evidence. We have not received a great amount of information, but all were very relevant to the plan and will help the review process.

Now that the evidence is in, the next steps for us is to submit it to the Technical Advisory Group and Ornithological Working Group (only ornithological evidence) for review and to create an advice note to the Sectoral Plan Programme Board.

As you all might be aware the ScotWind result accounted for Option Agreements over a 7000KM² area and a stated developer ambition of almost 25GW. Whilst these are just Option Agreements and in no way a guarantee that anything will be built, as all projects must still progress through the licensing and consenting process, there is a clear difference between the plan level assumptions and assessments and the potential capacity that may come forward as project applications. Therefore, the new information reflecting the ScotWind results will also be considered alongside the submitted evidence and now be evaluated as part of the Iterative Plan Review.

We are due to meet again this year. Given that we will also be reaching out shortly for the INTOG process and the creation of steering groups we would suggest the next meeting is set for late summer. We are of course happy to discuss or meet with you individually, as always.

Good Afternoon [redacted reg – 11(2)],

I hope you had a wonderful break.

The Project BOOST workshop 3.0 was very useful. I noted that BEIS are keen to see BOOST concluded in September and that key messages by each organisation are incorporated in the final report, which is to be supported by final data package.

And that BEIS also want to include future interaction with NSTA/ BEIS and TCE and hopefully CES, MS in the report.

As the project will be supported by a final data package (including the maps) to be used by BEIS in future policy development we were wondering if it might be prudent to make the following requests of TCE in preparation of the final report/ data package:

- a. that existing windfarms and windfarm lease rounds are included (sp. ScotWind and INTOG)
- b. that report make recommendations for future work required to understand potential overlap of different offshore sectors

c. that the maps of interaction with FOWS highlights the fields which intersect with FOWS hexagons and that filtering of the FOWS model runs / hexagons is avoided (or at the very least transparent)

- A. Agree a wind GW capacity to use on the analysis i.e. how much extra do we need to reach 140 GW (separate targets for Scotland and rest of UK)
- B. Agree wind energy density that will be used in analysis (a consistent value of 4MW/km² is proposed)
- C. Identify how many theoretical square kilometres are needed in Scotland / rest of UK to reach the GW capacity (Step 1 x Step 2)
- D. Select the number FOWS hexagons needed to reach the target area, starting with the most used hexagon working towards the least used. This is run separately for Scotland and rest of UK until the required areas are achieved
- E. Merge FOWS hexagons into a single polygon shape and combine with all existing wind agreements including ScotWind and R4 (not including Celtic Sea)
